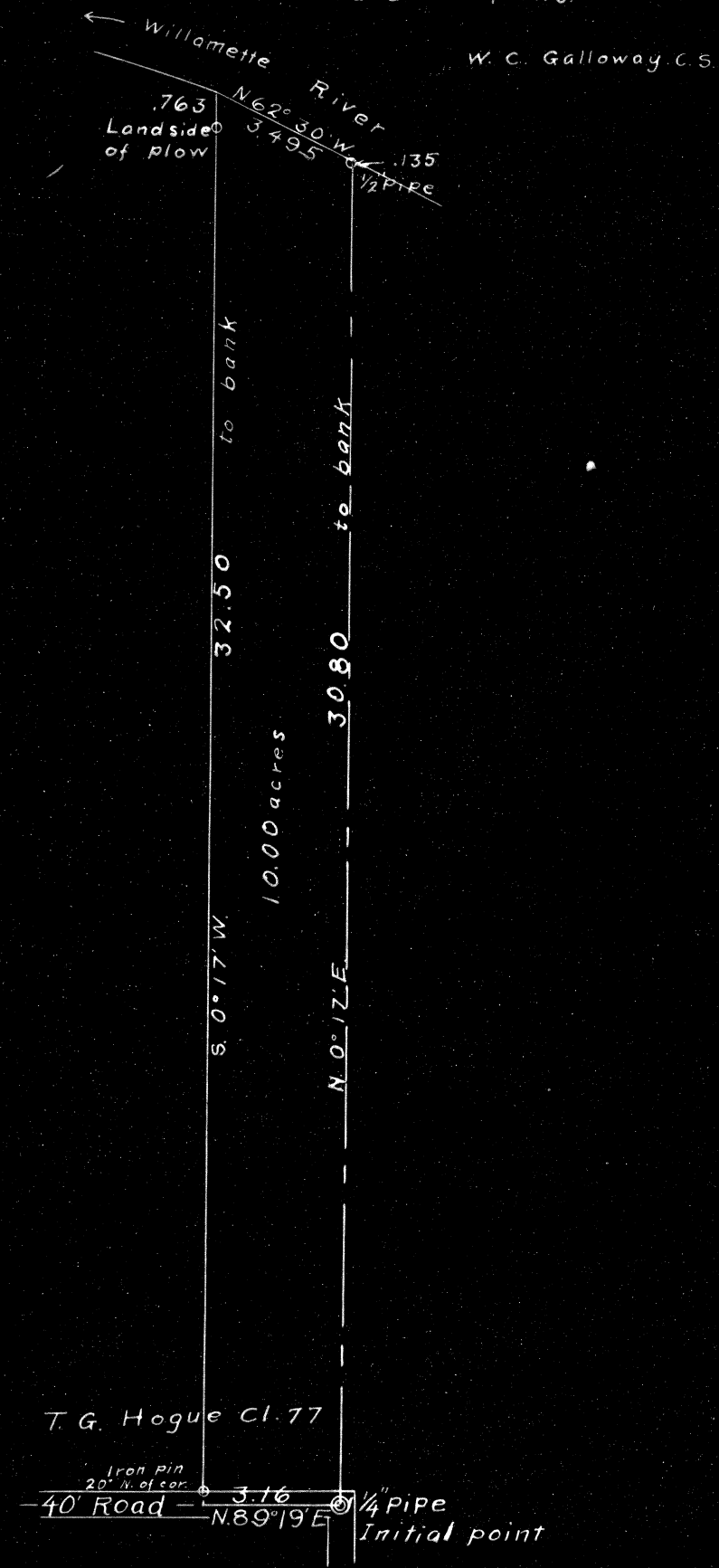


COUNTY SURVEY N°132

G. Hogue D.L.C. 77, T. 12 S. R. 5 W. of the Will. Mer. in Benton County, Oregon; and running thence N. 0° 17' E. along the east line of said claim 30.80 chs. to the south bank of the Willamette River; thence N. 62° 30' W. 3.495 chs. along the south bank of said river to a point .763 chs. N. 0° 17' E. of an iron, thence S. 0° 17' W. 32.50 chs. to the south line of said claim, thence N. 89° 19' E. 3.16 chs. to the place of beginning, containing 10.00 acres.
