- FOUND: 16" X 16" X 8" STONE WITH A PUNCH HOLE IN THE TOP CENTER FOR THE CORNER. THE STONE IS MARKED "CS" ON THE SOUTHWESTERLY SIDE AND IS 12" BELOW GROUND SURFACE (STONE 8" X 16" X 16" AS PER [3]).
- FOUND: 5/8" REBAR, 12" BELOW GROUND SURFACE, BEARS N 40° W 0.29 FOOT (5/8" IRON ROD NORTH EDGE OF STONE AS PER [10]). NOT SHOWN ON SKETCH.
- FOUND: 5/8" REBAR, BEARS S 3° 42' 20" E 195.56 FEET (5/8" ROD S 0° 32' W 195.36 FEET AS PER [10]). THE REBAR IS 1.1 FEET EASTERLY FROM A NORTH-SOUTH WOVEN WIRE FENCE.
- FOUND: 1" IRON ROD, 9" BELOW GROUND SURFACE, BEARS \$ 49° 53' W 2.21 FEET. THERE IS NO RECORD OF THIS BEING SET OR RECOVERED. THE RECORD PLAT OF NORTH PALESTINE CEMETERY CALLS FOR A BEGINNING CORNER AT THIS CLAIM CORNER, BUT IT DOES NOT DESCRIBE THE MONUMENT. THE 1" ROD IS ON THE NORTH SIDE OF A WOODEN CORNER POST TO A WEST-SOUTHWEST BY SOUTH WOVEN WIRE FENCE.


### MONUMENT SET (PROCEDURES AND DESCRIPTION):

SET: 2" INSIDE DIAMETER X 32" LONG IRON PIPE WITH A MAGNETIC BREAK-OFF BASE AND A 3 1/4" BENTON COUNTY BRASS CAP, STAMPED AS SHOWN, 4" ABOVE GROUND SURFACE AND IN THE SAME COORDINATE POSITION AS SAID RECOVERED STONE. BURIED THE STONE HORIZONTALLY ALONG THE WESTERLY SIDE OF THE NEW MONUMENT. LEFT THE RECOVERED 5/8" REBAR IN PLACE AS FOUND.
