TO REACH CORNER FROM THE INTERSECTION OF TAMPCO AND SOAP CREEK ROADS, GO NORTHEASTERLY ON SOAP CREEK ROAD FOR 0.6 MILES, THEN EASTERLY ON A GRAVEL DRIVEWAY (38665 SOAP CREEK ROAD) TO ITS EASTERLY TERMINUS, THEN EASTERLY FOR ± 100' TO CORNER.

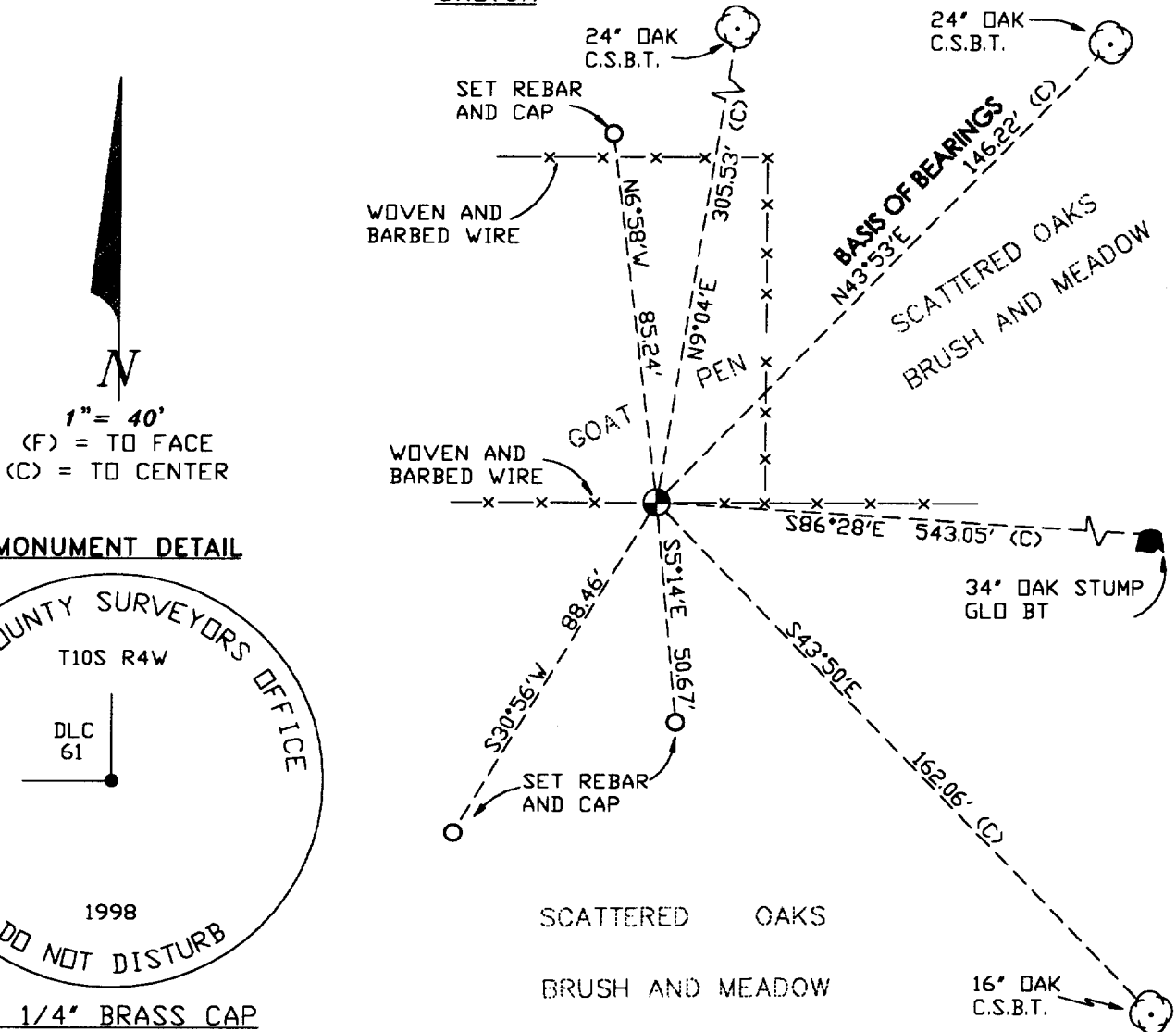

- FOUND: 3/4" INSIDE DIAMETER IRON PIPE, 10" DEEP IN AN EAST/WEST WOVEN AND BARBED WIRE FENCE FOR THE CORNER MONUMENT AS SET IN COUNTY SURVEY NO. 119 (RECORD NO. [03]).
 - FOUND: COUNTY SURVEYOR BEARING TREE, A 24" WHITE OAK WITH HEALED FACE, N43°53'E, 146.22' COMPARED TO RECORDS [08] AND [11]; 12" OAK, N43°53'E, 146.45'. SET ALUMINUM NAIL AND PLASTIC WASHER IN SIDE CENTER AT EASTERLY BASE.
 - FOUND: COUNTY SURVEYOR BEARING TREE, A 24" WHITE OAK WITH HEALED FACE, N9°04'E, 305.53' COMPARED TO RECORDS [08] AND [11] OF 8" OAK, NE, 305.51'. SET ALUMINUM NAIL AND PLASTIC WASHER IN SIDE CENTER AT EASTERLY BASE.
 - FOUND: COUNTY SURVEYOR BEARING TREE, A 16" WHITE OAK WITH HEALED FACE, S43°50'E, 162.06' COMPARED TO RECORDS [08] AND [11] OF A 14" OAK S44°E, 161.90'. SET ALUMINUM NAIL AND PLASTIC WASHER IN SIDE CENTER AT NORTHEASTERLY BASE. THIS BEARING TREE IS THE MOST SOUTHWESTERLY OAK IN A GROUP OF 4 (2 ALIVE, 1 DEAD AND 1 DOWN).
 - FOUND: PROBABLE GLO BEARING TREE, NOW A 34" WHITE OAK STUMP WITH NO VISIBLE REMAINING MARKS, S86°28'E, 543.05' COMPARED TO GLO RECORD OF 15" OAK, S87°E, 541.20' (FACE MEASURE). SET A 6" SPIKE AND BRASS WASHER IN TOP CENTER OF STUMP.
- NO OTHER RECORD EVIDENCE WAS FOUND AFTER A THOROUGH SEARCH OF THE AREA.

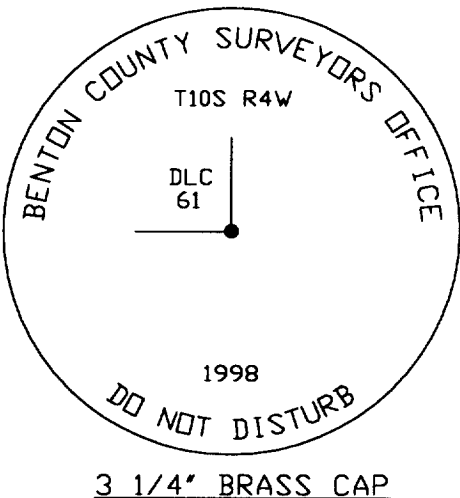

HELD THE POSITION OF THE SAID FOUND 3/4" IRON PIPE AS SET IN COUNTY SURVEY NO. 119 (RECORD [03]). SET A 2" INSIDE DIAMETER X 36" LONG, GALVANIZED IRON PIPE WITH A 3 1/4" BRASS DISK CONCRETED IN THE TOP, CENTERED OVER SAID 3/4" IRON PIPE, MARKED AS SHOWN BELOW.
