LOCATION AND COMMENTS:

THE CORNER IS LOCATED ON A MODERATELY SLOPING, NORTHEASTERLY FACING, WOODED HILLSIDE, ABOUT 250' SOUTHERLY OF WILLAMETTE INDUSTRIES ROAD NO. 10-5-26.0. TO REACH FROM THE INTERSECTION OF SOAP CREEK ROAD AND STAGE STOP LANE, FOLLOW SOAP CREEK ROAD SOUTHWESTERLY 0.42 MILES TO A GRAVEL, ORANGE GATED ROAD TO THE LEFT (10-5-26.0). FOLLOW SAID GRAVEL ROAD 0.55 MILES TO A DRAW AND A LOCATION TAG ON THE LEFT. THE CORNER IS POOR FOR PREMARKING AND GPS CONTROL.

MONUMENTS AND ACCESSORIES FOUND (CONDITION AND SOURCE):

FOUND: 20" x 12" x 8" STONE, 9" ABOVE GROUND SURFACE (AGS), SCRIBED "C46" ON THE NORTHWESTERLY FACE AND A DOT ON THE HIGH POINT WHERE RECORD [06] APPEARS TO HAVE TIED IT. AFTER REFERENCING AND REMOVING THE STONE IT WAS APPARENT THE STONE HAD BEEN TIPPED OVER IN A WESTERLY DIRECTION (UPHILL). THIS DISPLACEMENT WAS PROBABLY CAUSED BY THE ROOT SYSTEM OF AN 18" D. FIR 3.5' NORTHERLY OF THE STONE. STANDING THE STONE UPRIGHT CREATES A POSITION ABOUT 0.5' NORTHERLY.

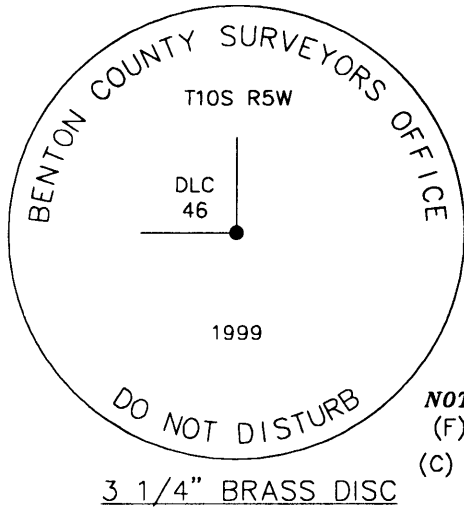

MONUMENT SET (PROCEDURES AND DESCRIPTION):

SET: 2" INSIDE DIAMETER BY 36" LONG GALVANIZED IRON PIPE, WITH A 3 1/4" BENTON COUNTY BRASS DISC, STAMPED AS SHOWN, CONCRETED IN THE TOP OF SAID PIPE. THIS POSITION WAS DETERMINED BY A DISTANCE-DISTANCE INTERSECTION FROM THE SOUTH QUARTER CORNER OF SECTION 26 AND THE NORTHEAST BEARING TREE AS COMPUTED FROM RECORD [02]. THIS POSITION SUPPORTS THE ANGLE BETWEEN THE NORTHWEST AND NORTHEAST BEARING TREES AS MEASURED BY RECORD [02] (98° 37'). IT FITS WITHIN REASON WITH THE DISTANCE MEASURED TO THE FACE OF THE NORTHWEST TREE BY RECORD [02]. RECORD [02] PROBABLY MISCALLED THE DIAMETER OF THE NORTHWEST TREE. IT IS MUCH MORE REALISTIC IF SAID TREE WAS ABOUT 62" IN 1947. THE HIGH POINT OF THE STONE AS RECOVERED IS ABOUT S 21° W~0.73'. BURIED SAID STONE ON THE WESTERLY SIDE OF THE NEW MONUMENT.

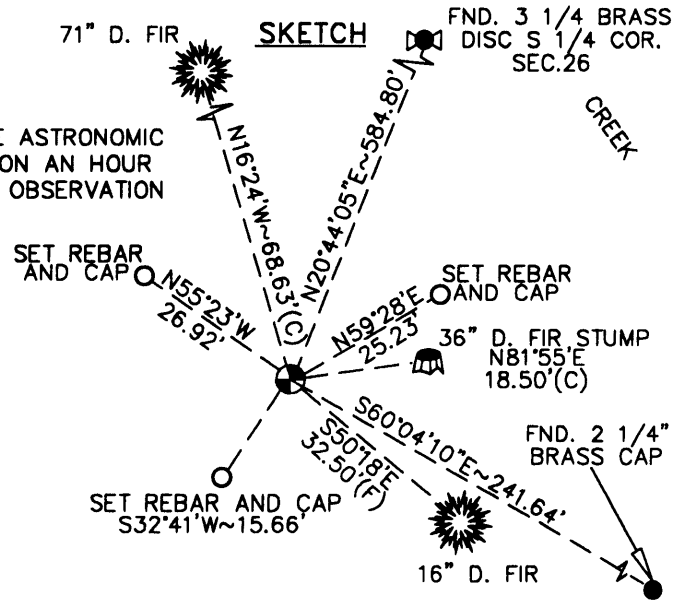
MONUMENT DETAIL
