GALLOWAY, C.S., WHICH WAS SET FROM ONE ORIGINAL GENERAL LAND OFFICE (GLO) BEARING TREE. THE BRASS DISK AND IRON PIPE FIT WELL WITH THE REMAINING GLO BEARING TREE AND THE GLO BEARING TREE STUMP. 




