LOCATION AND COMMENTS:

THE CORNER IS LOCATED IN A FIR TREE PLANTATION, APPROXIMATELY 175 FEET SOUTH FROM THE NORTHERLY EDGE AND APPROXIMATELY 145 FEET EAST FROM A WOVEN AND BARBED WIRE FENCE, WHICH BEARS N 23° W. SET A LOCATION TAG ON A FENCE POST. IT IS POOR FOR PREMARKING AND G.P.S. CONTROL.

MONUMENTS AND ACCESSORIES FOUND (CONDITION AND SOURCE):

- FOUND: BENT 5/8" X 2 1/2" BOLT WITH A 7/8" SQUARE HEAD, 7" BELOW GROUND SURFACE (5/8" X 2 1/2" BOLT AS PER [06]).
 - FOUND: 3 IRON RAILROAD PLATES, 11" BELOW GROUND SURFACE, AROUND SAID BOLT (RR FISH PLATE 2 1/2" BELOW GROUND SURFACE, 2 FISH PLATES 6" BELOW SURFACE AS PER [06]).
 - FOUND: PIECES OF TWO DIFFERENT SHADES OF BROWN GLASS AROUND SAID BOLT AND ANYWHERE FROM 18" TO 30" BELOW GROUND SURFACE (PABST BLUE RIBBON AND BLITZ WEINHARD QUART BOTTLES AS PER [06]).
 - FOUND: SMALL PIECES OF OLD ROTTEN FIR 30" BELOW GROUND SURFACE (4" X 4" X 36" FIR LIMB AS PER [02]).

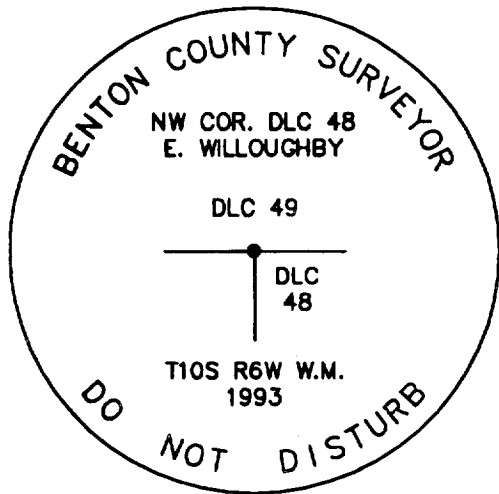
MONUMENT SET (PROCEDURES AND DESCRIPTION):

SET: 2" INSIDE DIAMETER X 36" LONG IRON PIPE WITH A 3 1/4" BENTON COUNTY BRASS CAP, STAMPED AS SHOWN, 10" BELOW GROUND SURFACE AND IN THE MEAN COORDINATE POSITION OF ALL OF THE RECOVERED CORNER MONUMENT EVIDENCE. BURIED THE THE IRON RAILROAD PLATES, THE BROKEN GLASS AND THE PIECES OF FIR AROUND THE NEW MONUMENT. BURIED SAID BOLT HORIZONTALLY ALONG THE NORTHERLY SIDE OF THE NEW MONUMENT.

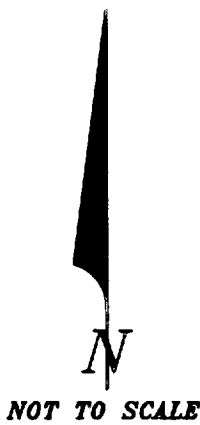

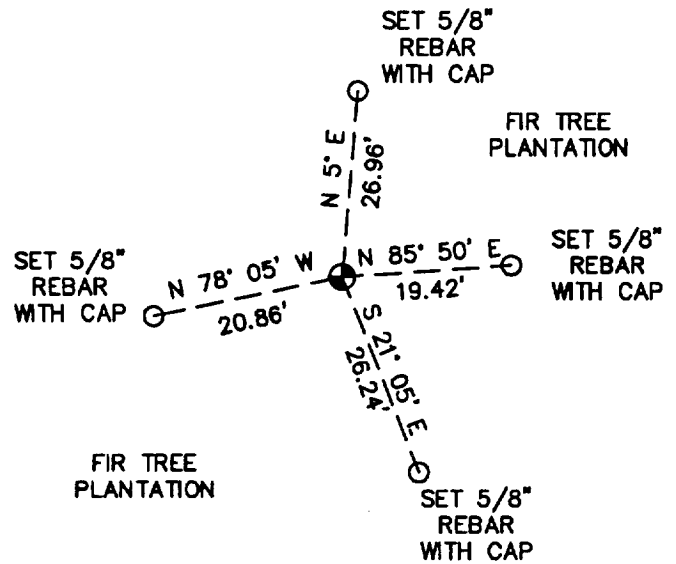
MONUMENT DETAIL

COMPASS DECLINATION IS 20° EAST. ALL MEASURED DISTANCES AND COMPASS BEARINGS ARE TO THE CENTER OF THE OBJECT, UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED. ALL BEARING TREES ARE PAINTED AND HAVE A B.T. TAG ATTACHED, FACING THE CORNER UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED. ALL NEW BEARING TREES HAVE A BRASS WASHER (STAMPED "BENTON COUNTY SURVEYOR") ATTACHED TO A SIDE CENTER, ALL LIVE BEARING TREES HAVE A PLASTIC WASHER (STAMPED "BENTON COUNTY SURVEYOR CORNER RESTORATION") ATTACHED TO THE BACK OF THE TREE OPPOSITE THE CORNER. ALL SET REBAR ARE 5/8" X 30" AND HAVE A YELLOW PLASTIC CAP (STAMPED "BENTON COUNTY SURVEYOR") ATTACHED TO THE TOP.
