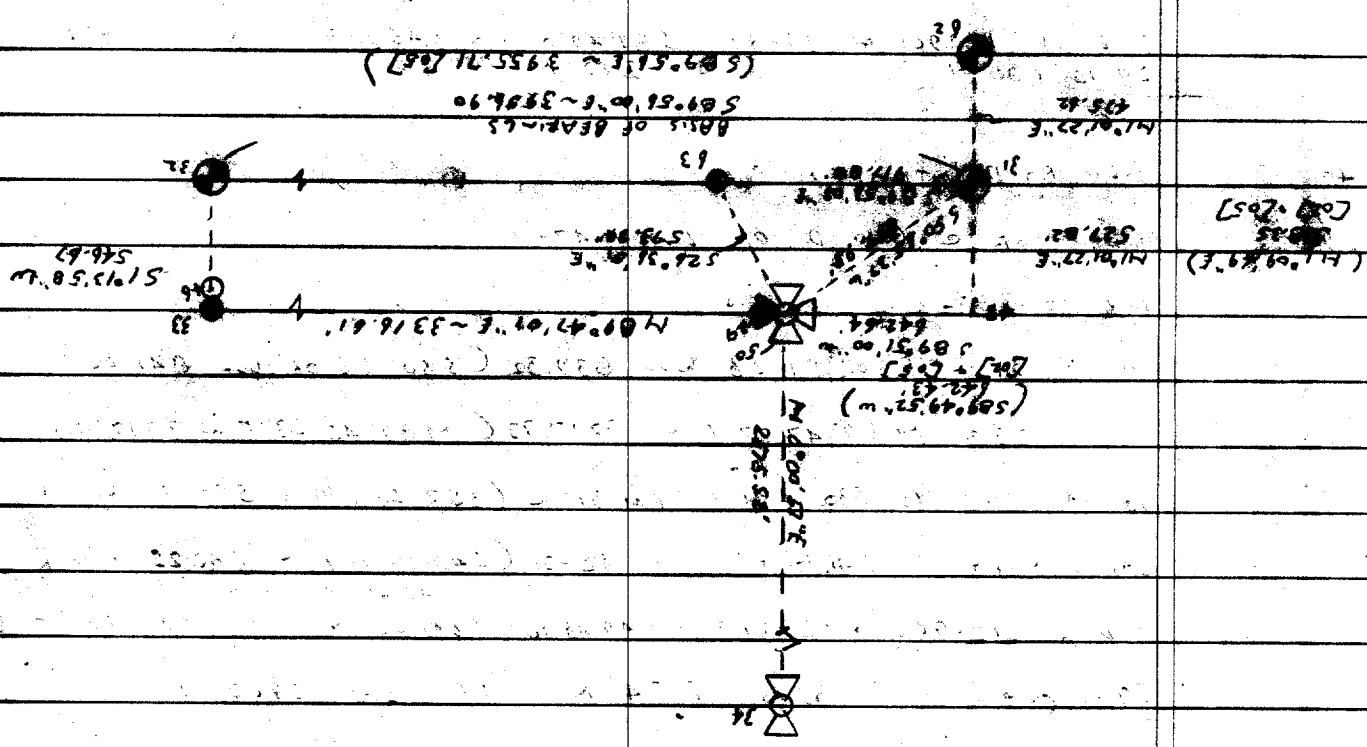

**COMMENTS/LOCATION/ETC:**

THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE IN THE FIELD NOTES OF RECORD [02] APPEARS TO HAVE POSITIONED THIS CORNER BY USE OF THE PASSING CALLS FROM THE ORIGINAL GENERAL LAND OFFICE DONATION LAND CLAIM SURVEYS. THE MAP FOR RECORD [02] CONTAINS BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO THE FOLLOWING ERRORS THAT CAN BE DETERMINED FROM RECOMPUTING SAID FIELD NOTES: BEGINNING AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 31 IN T 11 S, R 5 W THE BEARING AND DISTANCE TO THE FIRST CONCRETE POST TO THE EAST (POINT "A" ON THE RESTORATION SKETCH) WHICH W.C. GALLOWAY INTENDED TO BE AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE TOWNSHIP LINE AND THE EAST LINE OF THE LUKE MULKEY D.L.C. SHOULD BE N 89° 56' E 3317.12 FEET (FIELD NOTES) EAST 3303.63 FEET (MAP), THEN SOUTHERLY TO A CONCRETE POST AT THE S-SE CORNER OF SAID D.L.C. THE BEARING AND DISTANCE SHOULD BE S 1° 23' W 548.48 FEET (FIELD NOTES) S 1° 24' W 545.75 FEET (MAP), THEN WESTERLY TO A STONE AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SAID D.L.C. THE BEARING AND DISTANCE SHOULD BE N 89° 46' W 3958.60 FEET (FIELD NOTES) N 89° 45' W 3958.55 FEET (MAP). SAID POINT "A" AS COMPUTED FROM FIELD BOOK NO. 5 IS 3.84 FEET NORTH OF THE TOWNSHIP LINE.

RECORD [04] IS A TRANSCRIBED COPY OF RECORD [03] AND MAY CONTAIN ERRORS AND OMISSIONS.

ON THIS DATE WE RECOVERED A CONCRETE POST AT POINT "A", COMPUTED A POINT 3.84 FEET SOUTHERLY FROM SAID POINT "A", THEN PROJECTED A LINE WHICH BEARS S 89° 51' 00" W THROUGH A CONCRETE POST (POINT "B") WE RECOVERED NEAR SAID SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 31. IT APPEARS FROM THE FIELD NOTES IN FIELD BOOK NO. 5 THAT SAID POINT "B" WAS SET IN ITS INTENDED NORTH-SOUTH LOCATION BUT 6.53 FEET EASTERLY OF ITS INTENDED EAST-WEST LOCATION. WE REESTABLISHED SAID SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 31 S 89° 51' 00" W 6.53 FEET FROM SAID POINT "B".

**LOCATION AND COMMENTS:**

THE CORNER IS LOCATED IN A LEVEL PASTURE APPROXIMATELY 528 FEET NORTHERLY AT RIGHT ANGLES TO A WIRE FENCE AND APPROXIMATELY 35 FEET EASTERLY AT RIGHT ANGLES TO A SHALLOW DITCH.

**MONUMENTS AND ACCESSORIES FOUND (CONDITION AND SOURCE):**

FOUND: CONCRETE POST (POINT "B"), BEARS N 89° 51' 00" E \*\* 6.53 FEET. SAID CONCRETE POST IS 15" LONG, 4" IN DIAMETER AT THE TOP (8" ABOVE GROUND SURFACE), 5" IN DIAMETER AT THE BOTTOM (7" BELOW GROUND SURFACE) AND LEANING 0.4 FOOT SOUTHEASTERLY. SAID CONCRETE POST (3 1/2" X 18" CONCRETE POST AS PER RECORD [02]) WAS PRESUMED TO BE SET BY THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE AT THE TOWNSHIP CORNER AS PER RECORD [03] BUT TIES TO THE OTHER CORNER MONUMENTS AS SHOWN ON THIS RECORD WILL INDICATE OTHERWISE.

FOUND: A CONCRETE POST 5" IN DIAMETER (POINT "A"), BEARS N 89° 47' 01" E \*\* 3316.61 FEET (SET CONCRETE POST LARGE END UP 5" X 18", N 89° 45' 53" E 3317.12 FEET AS COMPUTED FROM RECORDS [02] AND [05]). THERE IS AN ORANGE FIBERGLASS "SURVEY MARKER" POST ON THE NORTHERLY SIDE OF SAID POST.

FOUND: 6" X 8" X ? STONE WITH A WEDGE SHAPED TOP AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE LUKE MULKEY DLC NO. 43, BEARS S 50° 55' 37" W \*\* 839.93 FEET (6" X 8" STONE, S 50° 56' 06" W 841.22 FEET AS COMPUTED FROM RECORDS [02] AND [05]). SAID STONE IS 5.3 FEET EASTERLY AND 1 FOOT NORTHERLY OF A NORTH-SOUTH AND EAST FENCE CORNER.

FOUND: 3 1/4" BENTON COUNTY BRASS CAP AT WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 31 AS PER CORNER RESTORATION NO. 115100140, BEARS N 0° 00' 57" E \*\* 2675.52 FEET (N 0° 23' E 2672.67 FEET AS PER RECORD [05]).

NO OTHER RECORD EVIDENCE WAS RECOVERED.

**MONUMENT SET (PROCEDURES AND DESCRIPTION):**

SET: 2" INSIDE DIAMETER X 36" LONG IRON PIPE WITH A 3 1/4" BENTON COUNTY BRASS CAP, STAMPED AS SHOWN, 5" BELOW GROUND SURFACE, AND IN THE SAME PHYSICAL LOCATION AS THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE INTENDED TO SET IT AS PER THE FIELD NOTES OF RECORD [02] (SEE COMMENTS/LOCATION/ETC: ON HISTORY FORM). BURIED THE RECOVERED 15" LONG CONCRETE POST HORIZONTALLY ALONG THE SOUTHERLY SIDE OF THE NEW MONUMENT.

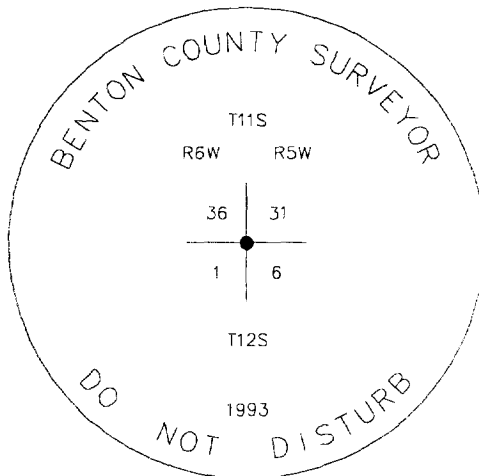

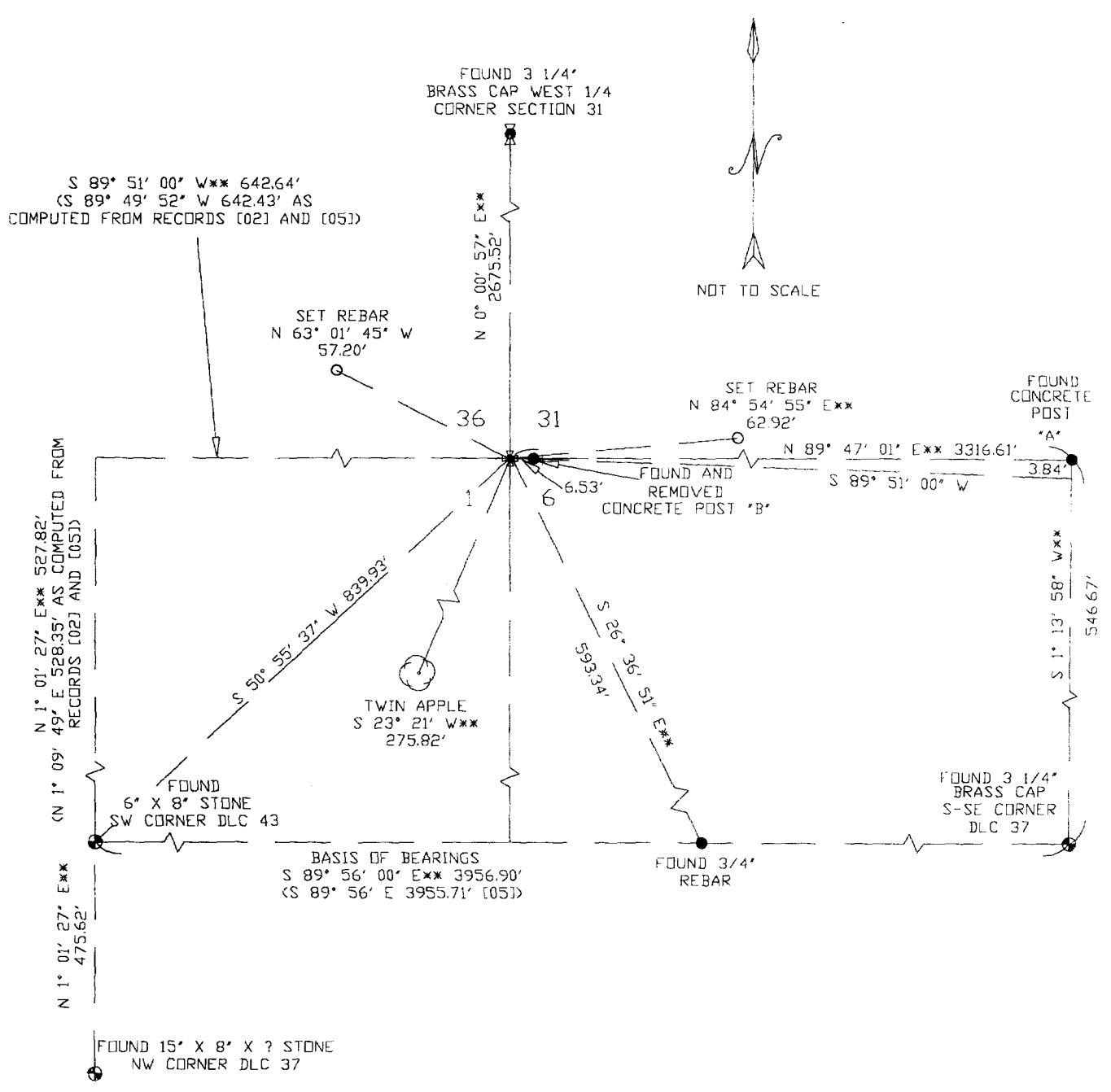
