LOCATION AND COMMENTS:

THE CORNER IS LOCATED ON A MODERATELY SLOPING, SOUTHERLY FACING, WOODED HILLSIDE. IT IS POOR FOR PREMARKING AND GPS CONTROL. IT IS ABOUT 250' NORTH-NORTHWESTERLY OF MILEPOST 1.32 ON SULFUR SPRINGS ROAD. MILEPOST 1.32 IS 1/4 MILE SOUTHEASTERLY FROM THE GATED FOREST ROADS AT THE LEWISBURG SADDLE AND 1.32 MILES WEST-NORTHWESTERLY OF LEWISBURG AVENUE.

MONUMENTS AND ACCESSORIES FOUND (CONDITION AND SOURCE):

FOUND: 3/4" INSIDE DIAMETER IRON PIPE WITH A 2 1/4" MCDONALD FOREST BRASS CAP, 14" ABOVE GROUND SURFACE, STAMPED AS SHOWN, FOR THE CORNER.

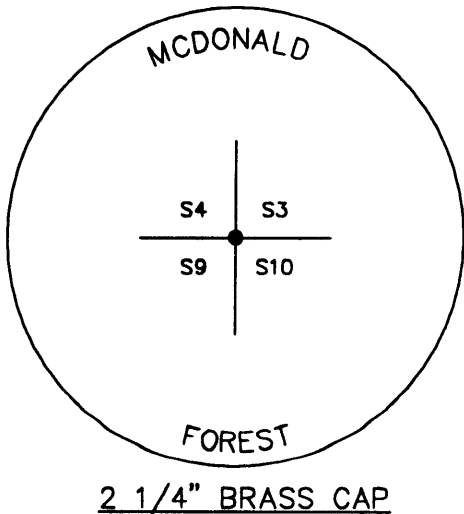

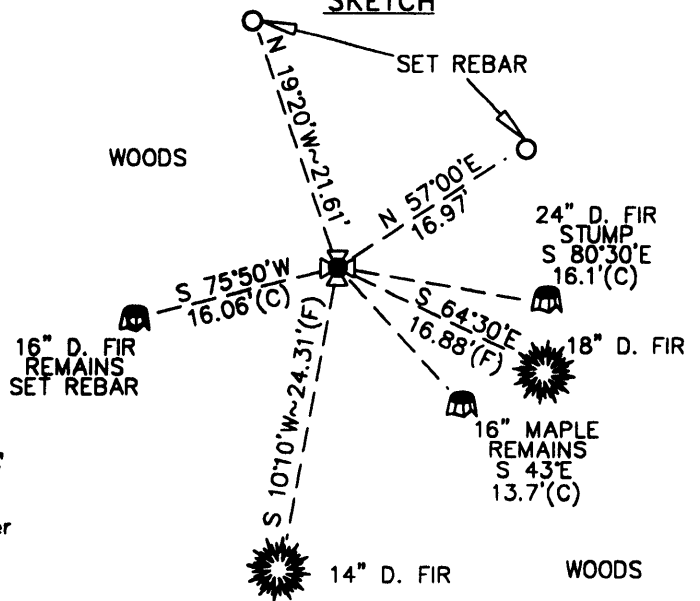

THE BEARINGS ARE MAGNETIC AND WERE OBSERVED WITH A 5 MINUTE STAFF COMPASS/TRANSIT.

ALL NEW BEARING TREES HAVE A PLASTIC WASHER (STAMPED "BENTON COUNTY SURVEYOR CORNER RESTORATION") ATTACHED (BY ALUMINUM NAIL) TO THE FACE, BELOW THE "BT" FOR DISTANCE AND ANGLE MEASUREMENT UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED. ALL SET REBAR ARE 5/8" X 30" AND HAVE A 1 3/4" RED PLASTIC CAP (MARKED "BENTON COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE") ATTACHED TO THE TOP.
