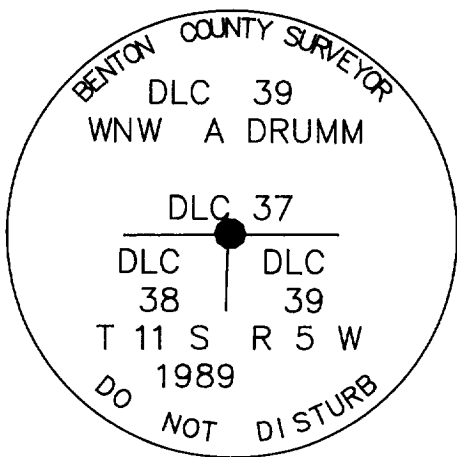

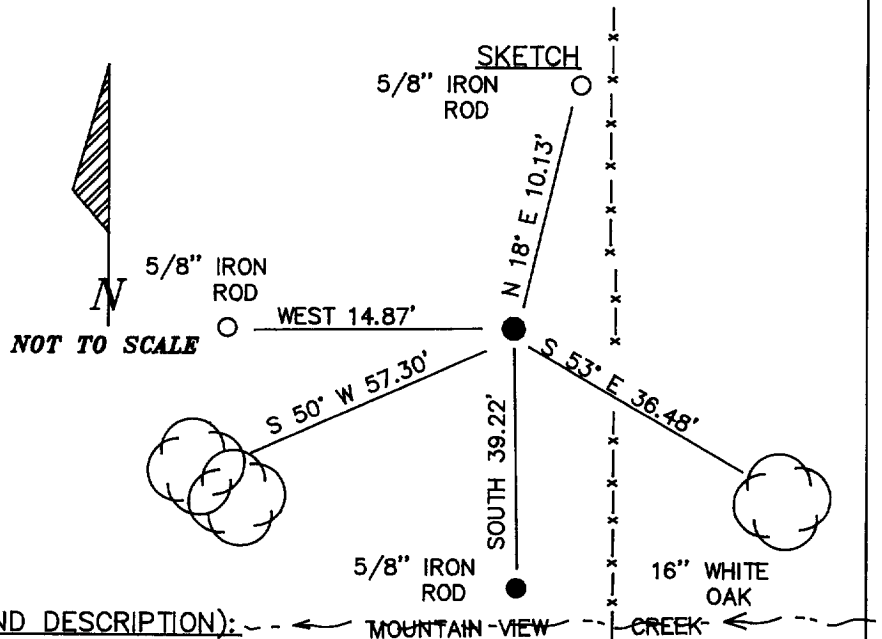

MONUMENT SET (PROCEDURES AND DESCRIPTION):

SET A 2 1/2" x 36" OUTSIDE DIAMETER IRON PIPE (OVER THE FOUND 1" IRON PIPE) WITH A 3 1/4" BRASS CAP MARKED AS SHOWN. MONUMENT IS 5" ABOVE THE GROUND SURFACE. AN ORANGE FIBERGLASS "SURVEY MARKER" SIGN BEARS EAST 1.50 FEET DISTANCE FROM CORNER. A WIRE FENCE BEARS EAST 7.60 FEET DISTANCE FROM CORNER. A SMALL CREEK BEARS SOUTH 46 FEET DISTANCE.

COMMENTS/LOCATION/ETC:

ON MAY 22, 1996 CURT LIESENFELT AND MARK ANDERSON RETIED THE RECORD [24] BRASS CAP AND FOUND IRON ROD TO RECORD [25] CONTROL. THE STATE PLANE VALUES GENERATED BY SAID TIE WERE 0.02 FEET SOUTHERLY, AND 0.11 FEET EASTERLY FROM THE RECORD [25] VALUES. A SEARCH WAS CONDUCTED FOR THE RECORD [03] MONUMENT AND THE RECORD [03] AND [09] NORTHEAST ACCESSORY, WITHOUT SUCCESS. IT WAS THE CONSENSUS OF THIS OFFICE TO NOT PUBLISH DIFFERENT STATE PLANE VALUES FOR SAID BRASS CAP
