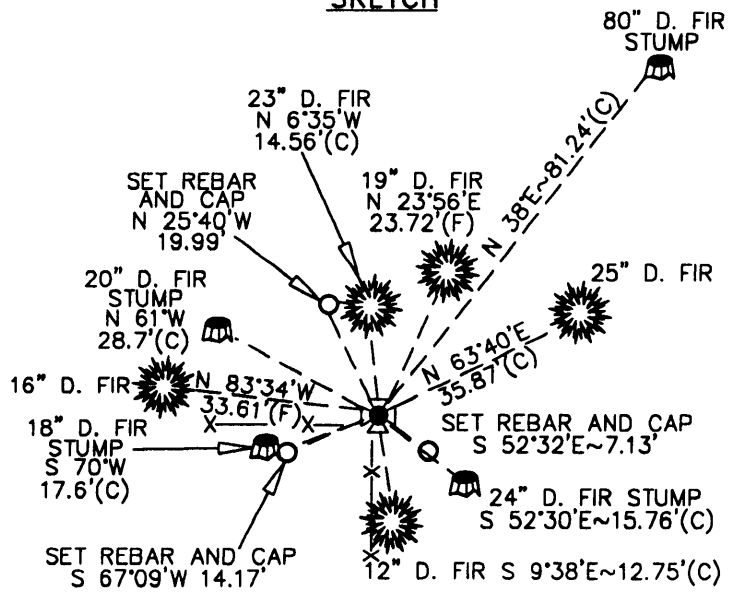
MONUMENT DETAIL
