LOCATION AND COMMENTS:

THE CORNER IS LOCATED IN THE NORTHWESTERLY CORNER OF A LIGHTLY WOODED MEADOW ON A MODERATELY SLOPING SOUTHWESTELRY FACING HILLSIDE, APPROXIMATELY 350 FEET NORTHEASTERLY FROM A WELL TRAVELED GRAVEL ROAD. IT IS GOOD FOR PREMARKING AND G.P.S. CONTROL.

MONUMENTS AND ACCESSORIES FOUND (CONDITION AND SOURCE):

FOUND: 3/4" REBAR FOR THE CORNER (3/4" IRON ROD AS PER RECORD [02]).

FOUND: 36" HOLLOW OAK WITH A CHOPPED OUT FACE, BEARS N 70° 34' W 122.85 FEET (18", N 71° 30' W 122.10 FEET FACE MEASUREMENT AS PER RECORD [01]). THIS TREE IS BARELY ALIVE. SET A PK NAIL AND BRASS WASHER 7 FEET HIGH IN THE NORTHERLY SIDE.

FOUND: 20" NORTHEASTERLY TRUNK OF A TWIN OAK WITH HEALED UPPER AND LOWER FACES, BEARS S 58° 23' W 62.70 FEET (18" NORTH OF DOUBLE OAK, S 57° 30' W 62.70 FEET AS PER RECORD [02]). SET A 5 1/2" SPIKE AND BRASS WASHER IN THE NORTHWESTERLY BASE. THE SOUTHWESTERLY TRUNK IS ALSO 20".

NO OTHER RECORD EVIDENCE WAS RECOVERED.

MONUMENT SET (PROCEDURES AND DESCRIPTION):

SET: 2" INSIDE DIAMETER X 36" LONG IRON PIPE WITH A 3 1/4" BENTON COUNTY BRASS CAP, STAMPED AS SHOWN, CENTERED OVER THE RECOVERED 3/4" REBAR AND 8" ABOVE GROUND SURFACE.

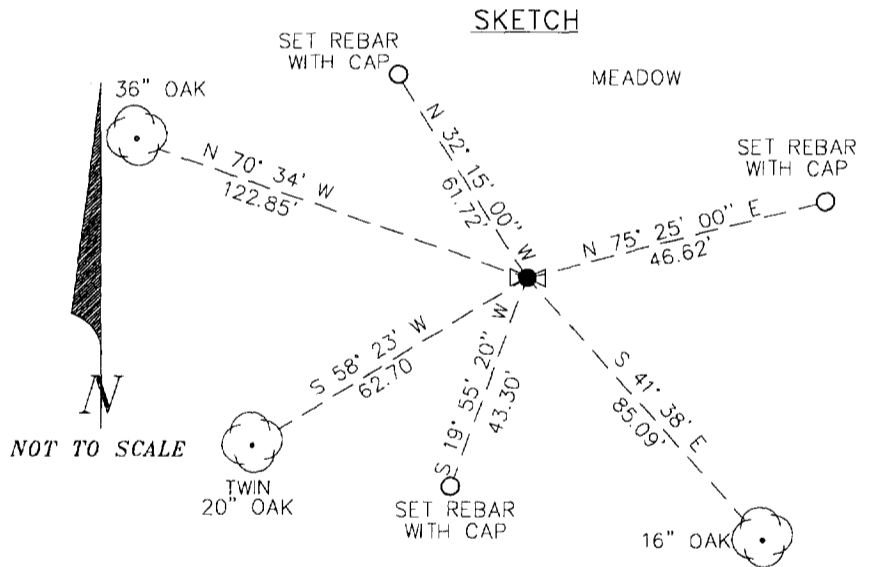
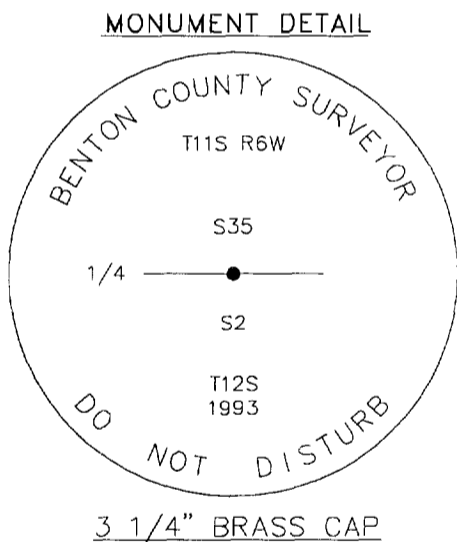
SET: REBAR (SEE NOTES), 5" BELOW GROUND SURFACE, BEARS S 19° 55' 20" W 43.30 FEET.

SET: REBAR (SEE NOTES), 5" BELOW GROUND SURFACE, BEARS N 32° 15' 00" W 61.72 FEET.

SET: REBAR (SEE NOTES), 5" BELOW GROUND SURFACE, BEARS N 75° 25' 00" E 46.62 FEET.

A 16" OAK, BEARS S 41° 38' E 85.09 FEET, FACED AND SCRIBED "1/4 S2 BT". SET A 5 1/2" SPIKE AND BRASS WASHER IN THE NORTHEASTERLY BASE.

SET: ORANGE FIBERGLASS "SURVEY MARKER" POST 1 FOOT NORTHERLY.



NOTES:

COMPASS DECLINATION IS 20° EAST. ALL MEASURED DISTANCES AND COMPASS BEARINGS ARE TO THE CENTER OF THE OBJECT, UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED. ALL BEARING TREES ARE PAINTED AND HAVE A B.T. TAG ATTACHED, FACING THE CORNER UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED. ALL NEW BEARING TREES HAVE A BRASS WASHER (STAMPED "BENTON COUNTY SURVEYOR") ATTACHED TO A SIDE CENTER UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED. ALL LIVE BEARING TREES HAVE A PLASTIC WASHER (STAMPED "BENTON COUNTY SURVEYOR CORNER RESTORATION") ATTACHED TO THE BACK OF THE TREE OPPOSITE THE CORNER UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED. ALL SET REBAR ARE 5/8" X 30" AND HAVE A YELLOW PLASTIC CAP (STAMPED "BENTON COUNTY SURVEYOR") ATTACHED TO THE TOP.
