THE CORNER IS LOCATED IN A MEADOW ON LOT 6, RAGUSE SUBDIVISION.

IT IS SUITABLE FOR PREMARKING AND HAS BEEN TIED INTO G.P.S. CONTROL.

**MONUMENTS AND ACCESSORIES FOUND (CONDITION AND SOURCE):**

FOUND: 36" OAK, BEARS N 1° 36' W 366.06' (10", N 1° 30' W 365.64 FEET FACE MEASURE AS PER RECORD [01]). SET A PK NAIL AND BRASS WASHER IN THE WESTERLY BASE.

FOUND: 42" OAK, BEARS S 43° 44' E 318.45 FEET (8", S 43° 30' E 318.12 FEET FACE MEASURE AS PER RECORD [01]). SET A 6" SPIKE AND BRASS WASHER IN THE NORTHEASTERLY BASE.

NO OTHER RECORD EVIDENCE WAS RECOVERED.

**MONUMENT SET (PROCEDURES AND DESCRIPTION):**

SET: 2" INSIDE DIAMETER X 36" LONG IRON PIPE WITH A 3 1/4" BENTON COUNTY BRASS CAP, STAMPED AS SHOWN AT THE RECORD ([01]) DISTANCE-DISTANCE INTERSECTION (ALLOWING FOR ORIGINAL FACE MEASUREMENTS) FROM THE RECOVERED ORIGINAL BEARING TREES.

**NEW ACCESSORIES:**

FOUND: 5/8" REBAR, BEARS N 15° 50' E 351.81 FEET. SAID REBAR IS AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF LOT 6 RAGUSE SUBDIVISION, 2" BELOW GROUND SURFACE AND 9" NORTHERLY FROM THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF A WOVEN AND BARBED WIRE FENCE.

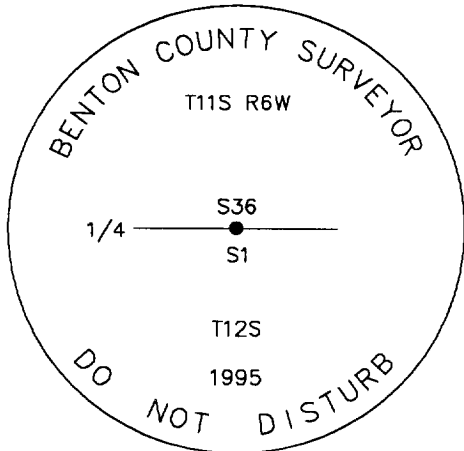
FOUND: 5/8" SMOOTH IRON ROD, BEARS S 27° 14' 15" E 178.99 FEET. SAID IRON ROD IS THE INITIAL POINT FOR RAGUSE SUBDIVISION AND 8" NORTHWESTERLY FROM A FENCE POST ANGLE POINT IN A NORTH BY SOUTH-SOUTHEASTERLY WOVEN AND BARBED WIRE FENCE.

FOUND: 5/8" REBAR AND CHEWED UP RED PLASTIC CAP AT THE WEST-SOUTHWEST CORNER OF LOT 6, RAGUSE SUBDIVISION, BEARS S 59° 25' 40" W 114.29 FEET.

FOUND: 5/8" REBAR AND RED PLASTIC CAP MARKED "LS 1103" IN A MONUMENT BOX AT THE CENTER LINE P.C. ON WORTH WAY, BEARS N 45° 36' 45" W 203.68 FEET.

SET: ORANGE FIBERGLASS "SURVEY MARKER" POST 1 FOOT SOUTHERLY.

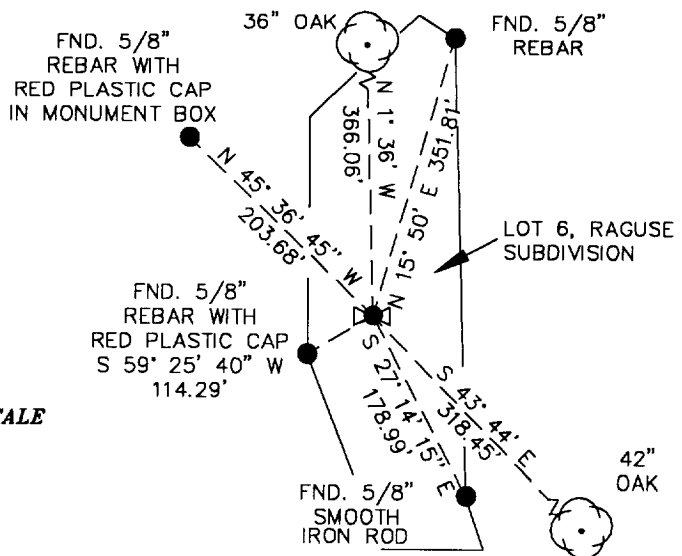
**MONUMENT DETAIL**

COMPASS DECLINATION IS 20° EAST. ALL MEASURED DISTANCES AND COMPASS BEARINGS ARE TO THE CENTER OF THE OBJECT, UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED. ALL BEARING TREES ARE PAINTED AND HAVE A B.T. TAG ATTACHED, FACING THE CORNER UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED. ALL NEW BEARING TREES HAVE A BRASS WASHER (STAMPED "BENTON COUNTY SURVEYOR") ATTACHED TO A SIDE CENTER UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED. ALL LIVE BEARING TREES HAVE A PLASTIC WASHER (STAMPED "BENTON COUNTY SURVEYOR CORNER RESTORATION") ATTACHED TO THE BACK OF THE TREE OPPOSITE THE CORNER UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED. ALL SET REBAR ARE 5/8" X 30" AND HAVE A YELLOW PLASTIC CAP (STAMPED "BENTON COUNTY SURVEYOR") ATTACHED TO THE TOP.
