LOCATION AND COMMENTS:

THE CORNER IS LOCATED ON A GENTLY SLOPING, HEAVILY WOODED AND BRUSHY, NORTHWESTERLY FACING HILLSIDE, 0.5 FOOT SOUTHERLY AT RIGHT ANGLES TO A PARTLY DOWN WOVEN AND BARBED WIRE FENCE, 90 FEET WESTERLY FROM AN OLD LOGGING ROAD. IT IS UNSUITABLE FOR PREMARKING AND G.P.S. CONTROL.

MONUMENTS AND ACCESSORIES FOUND (CONDITION AND SOURCE):

FOUND: 3/4" INSIDE DIAMETER IRON PIPE WITH THE TOP PINCHED SHUT FOR THE CORNER (3/4" PIPE AS PER RECORD [02]).
 FOUND: A PARTLY ROTTED 21" OAK STUMP, BEARS S 63° 30' W 31.44 FEET (10", S 62° W 31.02 FEET, FACE MEASUREMENT AS PER RECORD [01]). SET A PK NAIL AND WASHER IN THE NORTHWESTERLY BASE.
 NO OTHER RECORD EVIDENCE WAS RECOVERED.

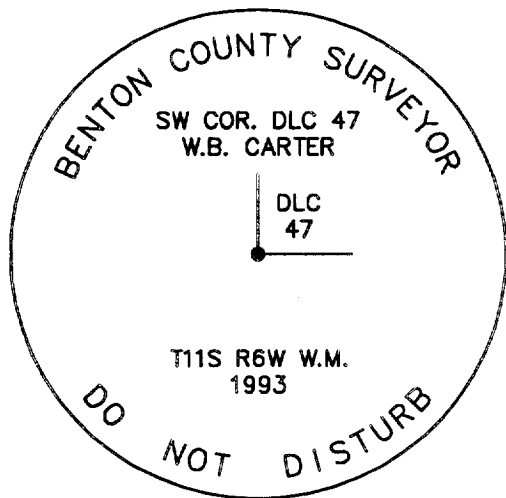

SET: 2" INSIDE DIAMETER X 36" LONG IRON PIPE WITH A 3 1/4" BENTON COUNTY BRASS CAP, STAMPED AS SHOWN, CENTERED OVER THE RECOVERED 3/4" PIPE.

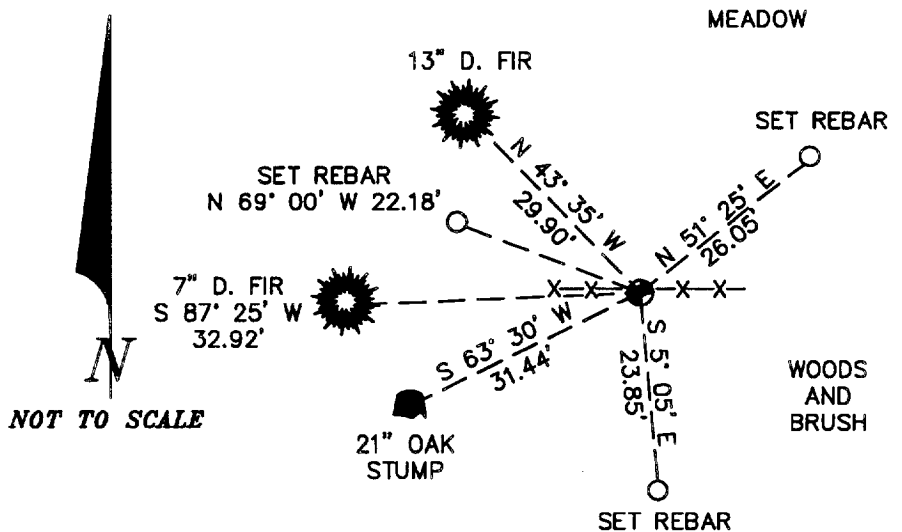

 SET: REBAR (SEE NOTES), 4" BELOW GROUND SURFACE, BEARS S 5° 05' E 23.85 FEET.

COMPASS DECLINATION IS 20° EAST. ALL MEASURED DISTANCES AND COMPASS BEARINGS ARE TO THE CENTER OF THE OBJECT, UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED. ALL BEARING TREES ARE PAINTED AND HAVE A B.T. TAG ATTACHED, FACING THE CORNER UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED. ALL NEW BEARING TREES HAVE A BRASS WASHER (STAMPED "BENTON COUNTY SURVEYOR") ATTACHED TO A SIDE CENTER UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED. ALL LIVE BEARING TREES HAVE A PLASTIC WASHER (STAMPED "BENTON COUNTY SURVEYOR CORNER RESTORATION") ATTACHED TO THE BACK OF THE TREE OPPOSITE THE CORNER UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED. ALL SET REBAR ARE 5/8" X 30" AND HAVE A YELLOW PLASTIC CAP (STAMPED "BENTON COUNTY SURVEYOR") ATTACHED TO THE TOP.
