- [01] ORIGINAL G.L.O. SURVEY BY DAVID STUMP, DATED NOVEMBER 6, 1856. *DEPOSITED STONE 5 X 8" SQUARE, SET MARKED POST, MADE MOUND AND TRENCH.*
- [02] COUNTY SURVEY NO. 9264 BY TED LANGTON OF NORTHSTAR SURVEYING, DATED NOVEMBER 19, 1996. *CONSIDERED THE CORNER LOST. REESTABLISHED WITH REBAR AND CAP WITH 4 BEARING TREES BY THE GRANT BOUNDARY METHOD.*

COMMENTS/LOCATION/ETC:

ON NOVEMBER 18TH AND 20TH, 1996 CURT LIESENFELT SEARCHED THE VICINITY WITHOUT SUCCESS FOR ANY OF THE ORIGINAL EVIDENCE. SEARCHING CONSISTED OF SOME PROBING FOR THE DEPOSITED STONE, WHICH LOCATED A LAYER OF SMALL STONES 6-12" BELOW THE GROUND AND TRYING TO FIND A PATTERN OF SHALLOW DEPRESSIONS AND RISES. THE SEARCH AREA EXTENDED ABOUT 17 FEET NORTH, 2 FEET EAST, 8 FEET SOUTH, AND 16 FEET WEST OF AN UNMARKED STONE 5" X 5" X 9" NORTHSTAR SURVEYING HAD FOUND SLIGHTLY EMBEDDED IN THE GROUND. THIS STONE IS ABOUT 1 FOOT WEST AND 16 FEET SOUTH OF A POSITION ESTABLISHED BY THE GRANT BOUNDARY METHOD FROM THE NORTHWEST AND SOUTHEAST CORNERS OF THIS CLAIM. BECAUSE OF HOW THE STONE WAS FOUND AND THE LACK OF CORROBORATIVE EVIDENCE TO SUPPORT ITS POSITION THIS OFFICE IS NOT WILLING TO ACCEPT THE STONE FOR THE CORNER. FOR MORE INFORMATION SEE RECORD [02].

THIS CORNER IS LOCATED ON A MODERATELY SLOPING, SOUTHWESTERLY FACING, LIGHTLY WOODED HILLSIDE. THIS AREA APPEARS TO HAVE NEVER BEEN LOGGED OR CULTIVATED, BUT IS CURRENTLY BEING USED TO GRAZE HORSES. TO REACH THIS CORNER START AT THE INTERSECTION OF BLAKSELY CREEK ROAD AND HIDDEN VALLEY ROAD, GO EASTERLY ON HIDDEN VALLEY FOR 1/8TH OF A MILE, TURN RIGHT THROUGH DOUBLE GREEN GATES ON A GRAVEL ROAD (NO. 11-6-22.0) AND FOLLOW FOR 1.2 MILES, TURN RIGHT ON ROAD NO. 11-6-23.0 AND FOLLOW FOR 1/4TH MILE. THE CORNER IS APPROXIMATELY 300 FEET UP THE HILL TO THE LEFT IN A LIGHTLY WOODED MEADOW.
