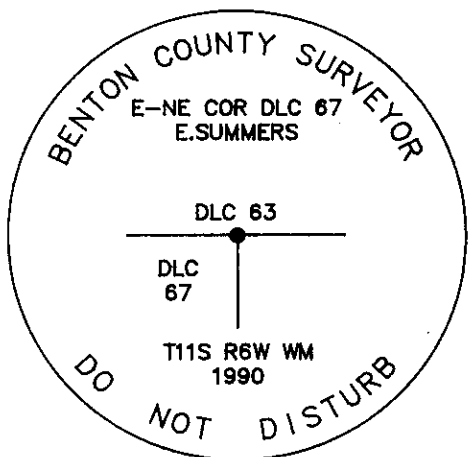

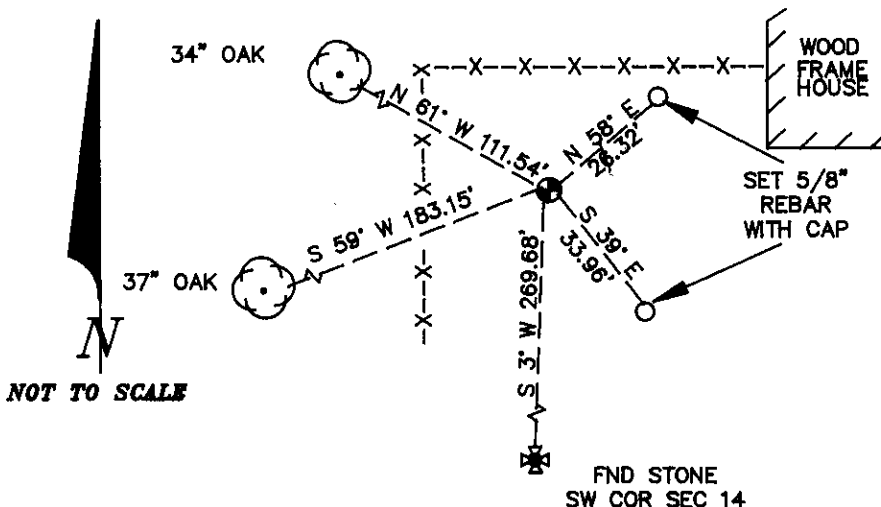

MONUMENT SET (PROCEDURES AND DESCRIPTION):

SET: 2" INSIDE DIAMETER X 36" LONG IRON PIPE WITH A 3 1/4" BENTON COUNTY BRASS CAP STAMPED AS SHOWN IN THE SAME POSITION AS THE BOTTLE. BURIED THE STONE ALONG THE SOUTHEAST SIDE, THE PIECE OF RED BRICK ALONG THE NORTH SIDE AND THE BOTTLE HORIZONTALLY ALONG THE WEST SIDE OF THE NEW MONUMENT. THE BRASS CAP IS 8" BELOW GROUND SURFACE.

NEW ACCESSORIES:

SET: 5/8" X 30" REBAR WITH A YELLOW PLASTIC CAP MARKED "BENTON COUNTY SURVEYOR" 6" BELOW GROUND SURFACE BEARS N 58° E 26.32 FEET. SET: 5/8" X 30" REBAR WITH A YELLOW PLASTIC CAP MARKED "BENTON COUNTY SURVEYOR" 6" BELOW GROUND SURFACE BEARS S 39° E 33.96 FEET. SET: ORANGE FIBERGLASS "SURVEY MARKER" POST 1 FOOT NORTHERLY.
