Post (now missing) from which a:

- 15" burnt cedar bears N50°E 225 lks.; now down 20" burnt cedar N44°40'E  
Roots around base, no scribe visible.
- 30" Fir bears N15W 464 lks.; now rotted stump in place, no scribe visible.
- 30" Fir bears S50°E 243 lks.; now missing.
- 24" Fir bears S25°W 366 lks.; now missing.
- Branch 3 lks. wide, South 7.45 chs. (now 504.5') course, East.
- Branch 2 lks. wide North 11.70 chs. (now 768.2') course East.

Set 1½" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked 'OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY T 11 S R 7 W S7, S8, S17, S18 1978 RS563", 33 inches in ground, and from which a:

- 16" Fir bears N77°E 13.5 ft. to face; scribed T11S R7W S8 BT.
- 19" Fir bears S71°W 28.5 ft. to face; scribed S18 T11S R7W RS 563 BT.
- 37" Fir bears S06°W 23.9 ft. to face; scribed S18 T11S R7W BT.
- 7" Alder bears N05½°W 26.9 ft. to face; scribed in bark  
T11S R7W S7 BT.
- Old fence post & Starkers white painted cedar post N71½°W 8.2'.

Set 4" x 4" x 72" white painted Cedar post 1.5' ft. NE of corner pipe.  
Oregon State Forestry Department metal location poster on 19" Fir BT S71°W 28.5'.
