A 6" DIAMETER WOOD CORNER POST BEARS N 10° E 1.50' DISTANCE.
A SMALL DRAINAGE DITCH IS 5.00' SOUTH AND 13.00' WEST OF CORNER.
SET AN ORANGE FIBERGLASS "SURVEY MARKER" SIGN ONE FOOT EAST OF CORNER.

NEW ACCESSORIES :

SET A 5/8" x 30" IRON ROD 8" BELOW THE GROUND SURFACE WITH A YELLOW PLASTIC CAP STAMPED "BENTON COUNTY SURVEYOR" BEARING WEST 5.75' DISTANCE.

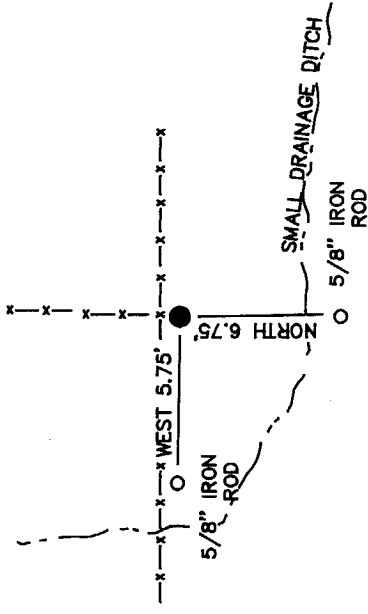
