LOCATION AND COMMENTS:

CORNER IS LOCATED ON A GENTLE SOUTHEASTERLY SLOPE IN A STAND OF MATURE D. FIR TIMBER. TO REACH CORNER FROM THE JUNCTION OF HARRIS AND TUM-TUM ROADS, TRAVEL SOUTHERLY ON TUM-TUM ROAD FOR 2.75 MILES AND PARK; THEN WALK EASTERLY FOR APPROXIMATELY 200 FEET TO CORNER. CORNER IS POOR FOR PREMARKING AND GPS CONTROL.



MONUMENT SET (PROCEDURES AND DESCRIPTION):

WE HELD THE CENTER OF THE 3 1/2" SECTION OF THE RECOVERED CHANNEL IRON FOR THE EXACT CORNER POSITION, WHICH COMPARES WELL WITH THE ABOVE ACCESSORIES FOUND. REMOVED CHANNEL IRON AND SET A 2" X 31 1/2" GALVANIZED IRON PIPE WITH A 3 1/4" ALUMINUM DISK CONCRETED IN THE TOP, 2" BELOW GROUND LEVEL AND MARKED AS SHOWN ON PAGE 2 OF 2. PLACED THE CHANNEL IRON ON THE WESTERLY SIDE OF NEW MONUMENT AT GROUND LEVEL. SET A 6 FOOT ORANGE CARSONITE "SURVEY MARKER" POST 0.5 FEET NORTH OF NEW MONUMENT.

COMPASS DECLINATION IS 20° EAST. ALL MEASURED DISTANCES AND BEARINGS ARE TO THE CENTER OF THE OBJECT, UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED. ALL BEARING TREES ARE PAINTED AND HAVE A B.T. TAG ATTACHED, FACING THE CORNER UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED. ALL NEW BEARING TREES HAVE A PLASTIC WASHER (STAMPED "SURVEYOR MARKER DO NOT REMOVE") ATTACHED BY AN ALUMINUM NAIL TO THE FACE, BELOW THE "BT" FOR DISTANCE AND ANGLE MEASUREMENT UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED. 
