LOCATION AND COMMENTS:

THE CORNER IS LOCATED IN A GRASS FIELD N 83° 30' 10" E 915.25 FEET FROM THE CENTER OF THE TOP CASING OF THE FRONT DOOR (EAST DOOR) OF THE GREENBERRY STORE. IT IS SUITABLE FOR PREMARKING AND G.P.S. CONTROL.

MONUMENTS AND ACCESSORIES FOUND (CONDITION AND SOURCE):

- FOUND: 1 1/8" IRON ROD, 16" BELOW GROUND SURFACE FOR THE CORNER (1 1/8" IRON ROD AS PER RECORD [08]). ALSO FOUND A HORSESHOE, 2 METAL PLATES AND HALF OF A RED BRICK AROUND SAID IRON ROD.
- FOUND: 3 1/4" BENTON COUNTY BRASS CAP AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 10 AS PER CORNER RESTORATION NO. 4095, BEARS S 0° 12' W 2649.54 FEET (S 0° 12' W 2649.50 FEET AS PER RECORD [05]). THIS IS THE BASIS OF BEARINGS FOR THIS RESTORATION.
- FOUND: 3/4" INSIDE DIAMETER IRON PIPE WITH A RAGGED TOP, 6" BELOW GROUND SURFACE, BEARS S 0° 12' 10" W 1324.69 FEET (1 1/2" PIPE WITH FAUCET, S 0° 12' W 1324.75 FEET AS PER RECORD [05]); 3/4" PIPE, S 0° 11' 40" W 1324.75 FEET AS PER RECORD [07]). SAID PIPE IS APPROXIMATELY 6" SOUTHERLY OF AN EAST-WEST WIRE FENCE.

NO OTHER RECORD EVIDENCE WAS RECOVERED.

MONUMENT SET (PROCEDURES AND DESCRIPTION):

LOWERED THE RECOVERED IRON ROD TO 18" BELOW GROUND SURFACE AND SET A PUNCH HOLE IN THE TOP CENTER. BURIED THE MISCELLANEOUS IRON OBJECTS AND BRICK AROUND THE ROD.

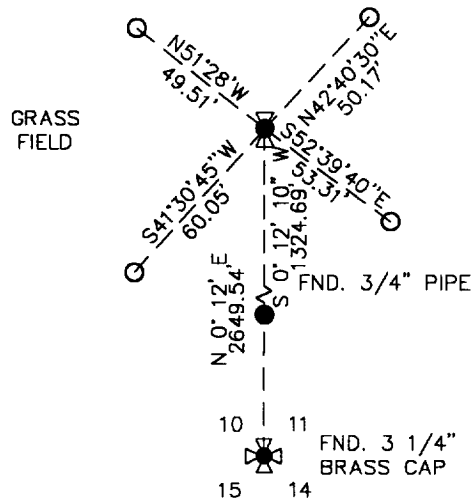

TAG ATTACHED, FACING THE CORNER UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED. ALL NEW BEARING TREES HAVE A BRASS WASHER (STAMPED "BENTON COUNTY SURVEYOR") ATTACHED TO A SIDE CENTER UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED. ALL LIVE BEARING TREES HAVE A PLASTIC WASHER (STAMPED "BENTON COUNTY SURVEYOR CORNER RESTORATION") ATTACHED TO THE BACK OF THE TREE OPPOSITE THE CORNER UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED.
