COLLIER, D.S., DATED FEBRUARY 9, 1892. *SET STONE 12" X 10" X 8", 8" IN GROUND, MARKED "1/4" ON WEST FACE, FROM WHICH A CEDAR 40" DIA BEARS S41°E, 65 LINKS (42.90 FEET), MARKED "1/4SBT"; CEDAR 40" DIA BEARS N68°W, 34 LINKS (22.44 FEET), MARKED "1/4SBT".*

[02] BUREAU OF LAND MANAGEMENT (BLM) NOTES BY DANNY J. NEVIN, CADASTRAL SURVEYOR, DATED SEPTEMBER 30, 1998. *POINT AT PROPORTIONATE DISTANCE. THERE IS NO REMAINING EVIDENCE OF THE ORIGINAL CORNER. SET A STAINLESS STEEL POST, 28" LONG, 2-1/2" DIA, 24" IN THE GROUND, WITH BRASS CAP MARKED "T13S R7W 1/4 S17 S16 1998" FROM WHICH A FIR 23" DIA BEARS S32°E, 35-1/2 LINKS (23.43 FEET), MARKED "1/4 S16 BT"; FIR 26" DIA BEARS S83°W, 89 LINKS (58.74 FEET), MARKED "1/4 S17 BT". DEPOSIT A MAGNET IN A WHITE PLASTIC CASE AT THE BASE OF THE STAINLESS STEEL POST.*
