LOCATION AND COMMENTS:

FROM THE JUNCTION OF HIGHWAY 34 AND WINNEY ROAD (PRIVATE ROAD NO. 3157), DRIVE 0.4 MILES NORTH ON WINNEY ROAD. CORNER IS 15' WEST OF ROAD CENTERLINE, AND 20' NORTH OF A GRAVEL SIDE ROAD.

MONUMENTS AND ACCESSORIES FOUND (CONDITION AND SOURCE):

FOUND: 13 X 8 X 6 STONE (NO MARKS) LYING ON IT'S SIDE. TIED CENTER OF STONE. ALSO STOOD STONE UP AND TIED CENTER. ALSO FOUND 3/4" TIE ROD (NO RECORD) BESIDE OLD FENCE POST POINT. SINCE THE STONE APPEARS TO HAVE BEEN DISTURBED, AND THERE IS NO RECORD OF THE TIE ROD, WE RESET THE CORNER AT RECORD DISTANCE FROM THE FOUND BT'S. FROM THE CORNER TO CENTER OF STONE AS FOUND = S15°W, 0.86 FT. FROM THE CORNER TO CENTER OF STONE AS STOOD UP = S61°W, 0.40 FT. FROM THE CORNER TO THE TIE ROD = S49°W, 1.40 FT.

FOUND: 36" OAK STUB, S19°22'W, 403.92 FT. TO FACE (24" OAK, S19°W, 403.92 FT. AS PER RECORD [1]). NO MARKS VISIBLE

FOUND: 26" OAK, S79°14'W, 252.12 FT. (14" OAK, S79°W, 252.12 FT. AS PER RECORD [2]). SCRIBING VISIBLE: "CS 55 BT". SET 6" SPIKE WITH BCBW IN SOUTHERLY BASE.

MONUMENT SET (PROCEDURES AND DESCRIPTION):

SET: 2" INSIDE DIAMETER X 30" LONG GALVANIZED IRON PIPE, WITH 2 1/2" BRASS CAP, FOR THE CORNER. CAP IS STAMPED AS SHOWN BELOW. BURIED STONE ALONGSIDE CAP. LEFT TIE ROD AND WOOD POST AS FOUND. BUILT MOUND OF STONE AROUND CORNER. CORNER LIES IN SMALL DEPRESSION 2 1/2' BELOW SURROUNDING GROUND, AND 4' BELOW ROAD SURFACE.

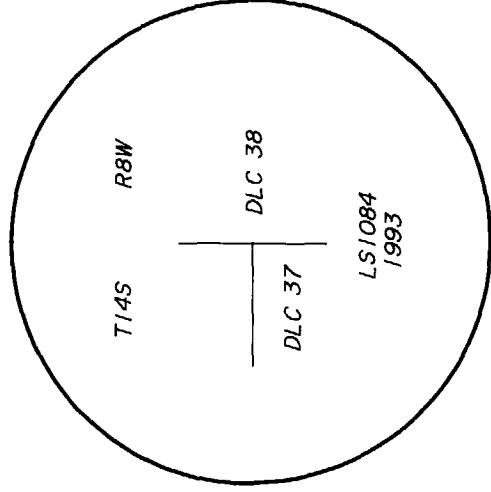

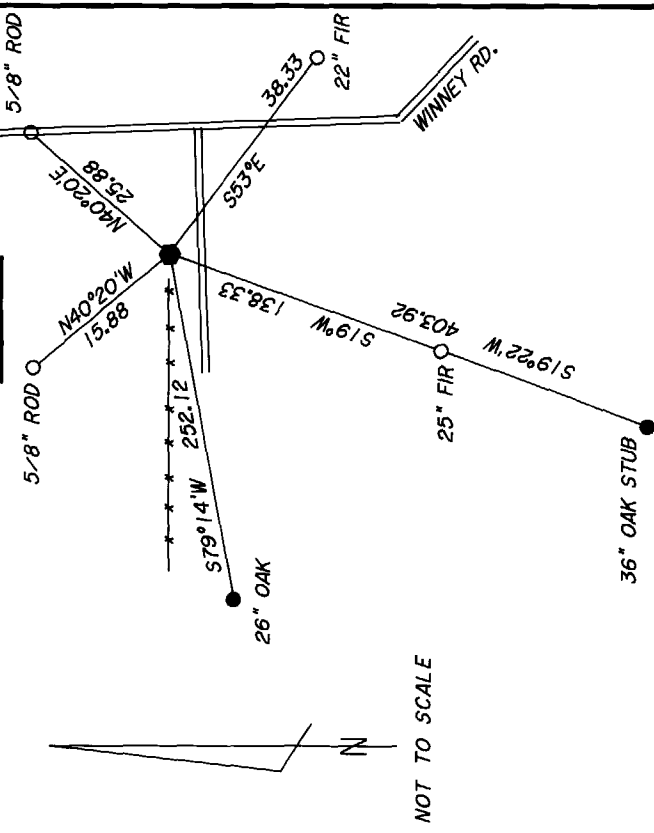
