A fir, 13 ins. diam., bears N. 66½° E., 73 lks.
dist., mkd. T14S R8W S31 BT.

A fir, 21 ins. diam., bears S. 77½° E., 44 lks.
dist., mkd. T15S R8W S6 BT.

A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears S. 4½° W., 39 lks.
dist., mkd. X BT.

A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears N. 26½° W., 82½ lks.
dist., mkd. T14S R9W S36 BT.

From this point, the cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7, and 12, on the W. bdy. of T. 15 S., R. 8 W., bears S. 0° 47' E., 80.72 chs. dist., described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of a portion of the W. bdy. of T. 15 S., R. 8 W., executed concurrently under this same group.

This control line was fully retraced, and no evidence of intervening corners was recovered.

From this same point, the original line object bet. secs. 1 and 36, Tps. 14 and 15 S., R. 9 W., bears N. 88° 04' W., 4.065 chs. dist., a granite boulder, 20 ft. x 13 ft., projecting 3 ft. above ground on the downhill side. The upper side is covered with dirt eroding from the hillside above. This point now becomes an angle point.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 15 ins. in the ground, to solid rock, on top and in center of the granite boulder, supported in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd.
