**LOCATION AND COMMENTS:**

THE CORNER IS LOCATED ON A HEAVILY WOODED, MODERATELY SLOPING, SOUTHWESTERLY FACING RIDGE APPROXIMATELY 100 FEET SOUTHWESTERLY FROM AN OLD LOG ROAD ACCESSIBLE WITH SMALL OFF ROAD VEHICLES. TO REACH FOLLOW THE LOGGING ROADS AS SHOWN ON THE GLENBROOK QUADRANGLE MAP. THIS CORNER IS UNSUITABLE FOR PRE-MARKING AND GPS CONTROL.

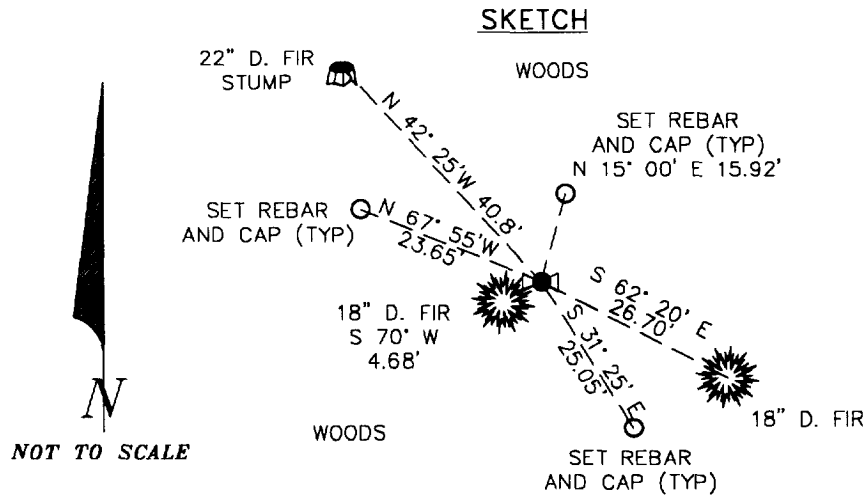
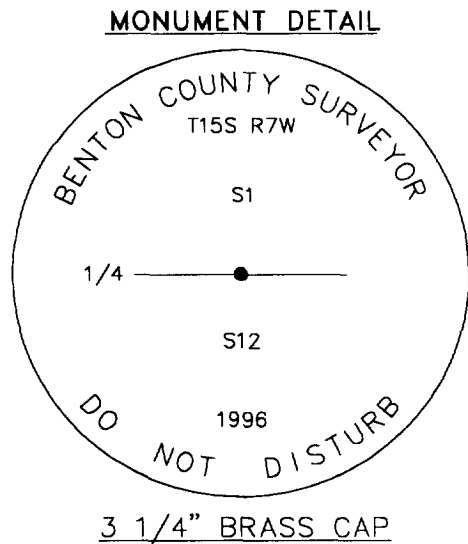
FOUND: GLO BRASS CAP MONUMENT WITH THE TOP 2 FEET BENT SOUTHWESTERLY FOR THE CORNER. THE BRASS CAP WAS STAMPED "1/4 S1 S12 1940" (IRON POST WITH BRASS CAP AS PER RECORD [02]).  
 FOUND: 3" X 4" X 10" PIECE OF YEW NEAR THE BASE OF SAID GLO MONUMENT (3" X 3" X 36" YEW POST AS PER RECORD [01], BURIED AT BASE AS PER RECORD [02]).  
 FOUND: MOSTLY ROTTED 22" D. FIR STUMP BEARS N 42° 25' W 40.8 FEET (12", N 42° W 40.26 FEET, FACE MEASUREMENT AS PER RECORD [01], 22" AS PER RECORD [02]). SET A BEARING TREE TAG ON TOP OF SAID STUMP.  
 NO OTHER RECORD EVIDENCE WAS RECOVERED.

**MONUMENT SET (PROCEDURES AND DESCRIPTION):**

SET: 2" INSIDE DIAMETER X 36" LONG IRON PIPE WITH A 3 1/4" BENTON COUNTY BRASS CAP, STAMPED AS SHOWN, IN THE SAME HORIZONTAL POSITION AS THE RECOVERED STRAIGHT BASE OF SAID GLO MONUMENT, BURIED SAID PIECE OF YEW AND GLO MONUMENT AROUND THE BASE OF THE 2" PIPE.

SET: 5/8" REBAR (SEE NOTES), BEARS N 15° 00' E 15.92 FEET.  
 18" D. FIR BEARS S 62° 20' E 26.70', FACED AND SCRIBED "1/4 S12 BT". SET A 5 1/2" SPIKE AND BRASS WASHER IN NORTHERLY BASE.  
 SET: 5/8" REBAR (SEE NOTES). BEARS S 31° 25' E 25.05 FEET.  
 18" D. FIR BEARS S 70° W 4.68', FACED AND SCRIBED "1/4 S 12 BT". SET A 5 1/2" SPIKE AND BRASS WASHER IN SOUTHERLY BASE.  
 SET: 5/8" REBAR (SEE NOTES), BEARS N 67° 55' W 23.65 FEET.  
 SET: ORANGE FIBERGLASS "SURVEY MARKER" POST 1 FOOT SOUTHWESTERLY.  
 SET: LOCATION TAG ON THE 6" TRUNK OF TRIPLE ALDER ON THE NORTHWESTERLY SIDE OF AN OLD LOGGING ROAD, THE CORNER BEARS S 60° W 103 FEET.



**NOTES:**

COMPASS DECLINATION IS 20° EAST. ALL MEASURED DISTANCES AND COMPASS BEARINGS ARE TO THE CENTER OF THE OBJECT, UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED. ALL BEARING TREES ARE PAINTED AND HAVE A B.T. TAG ATTACHED, FACING THE CORNER UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED. ALL NEW BEARING TREES HAVE A BRASS WASHER (STAMPED "BENTON COUNTY SURVEYOR") ATTACHED TO A SIDE CENTER UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED. ALL LIVE BEARING TREES HAVE A PLASTIC WASHER (STAMPED "BENTON COUNTY SURVEYOR CORNER RESTORATION") ATTACHED TO THE BACK OF THE TREE OPPOSITE THE CORNER UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED. ALL SET REBAR ARE 5/8" X 30" AND HAVE A YELLOW PLASTIC CAP (STAMPED "BENTON COUNTY SURVEYOR") ATTACHED TO THE TOP.
