Survey made for Frank H. Hughson and Elmer J. Harder, July 12, 1922.

Both parties were given notice by registered letter on July 5, 1922.

Notes of survey:-

Beginning at a 1 1/4" pipe, the northeast corner of the John Q. Thornton D.L.C. 37, T.10 S., R.3 W., Will. Mex., Benton County, Oregon; from which a stone bears N. 76° 15' W. 1.92 chains, a fir 2 1/4" in diameter bears N. 64° 23' W. 2.456 chains, the southwest corner of a house bears N. 6 3/4° W. 1.53 chains, and a cherry 7" in diameter bears N. 50° 50' E. 1.226 chains; thence N. 76° 15' W. along the south line of the Sarah Adkins D.L.C. 45 17.980 chains to a 1 1/4" pipe which is S. 76° 15' E. 1.983 chains from the southwest corner of said claim; thence S. 0° 03' E. 29.22 chains to a 1 3/4" pipe - this being the line between the parties above mentioned.
