Know all men by these presents that I, W. C. Post proprietor and owner in fee simple of the Town of Summitville in Benton County, State of Oregon, as designated on this map and plat and situate in and comprising a part of S. E. 1/4 of S. E. 1/4 of Section 6, T. 11 S. R. 7 W. "Will. Mer." hereby lay out said premises as a Town to be known as the Town of Summitville in Blocks 215 feet long by 200 feet wide, with an alley running through center of each block, divided into 16 lots each 100 by 25 feet and streets 60 feet wide, except first street which is 50 feet wide, as shown on this plat, and I hereby dedicate said streets to the use of the Public.
