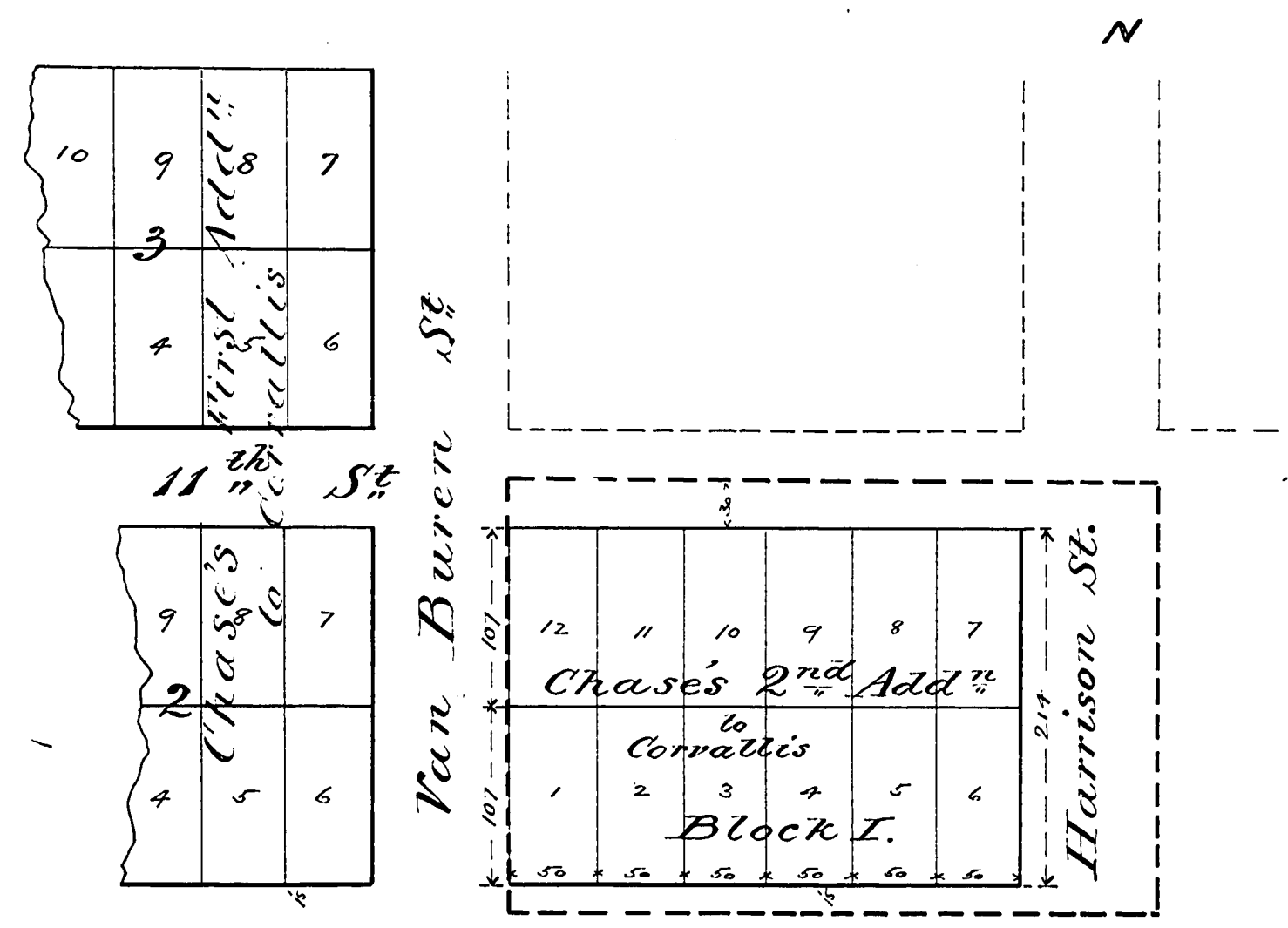


# Chase's Second Addition to Corvallis

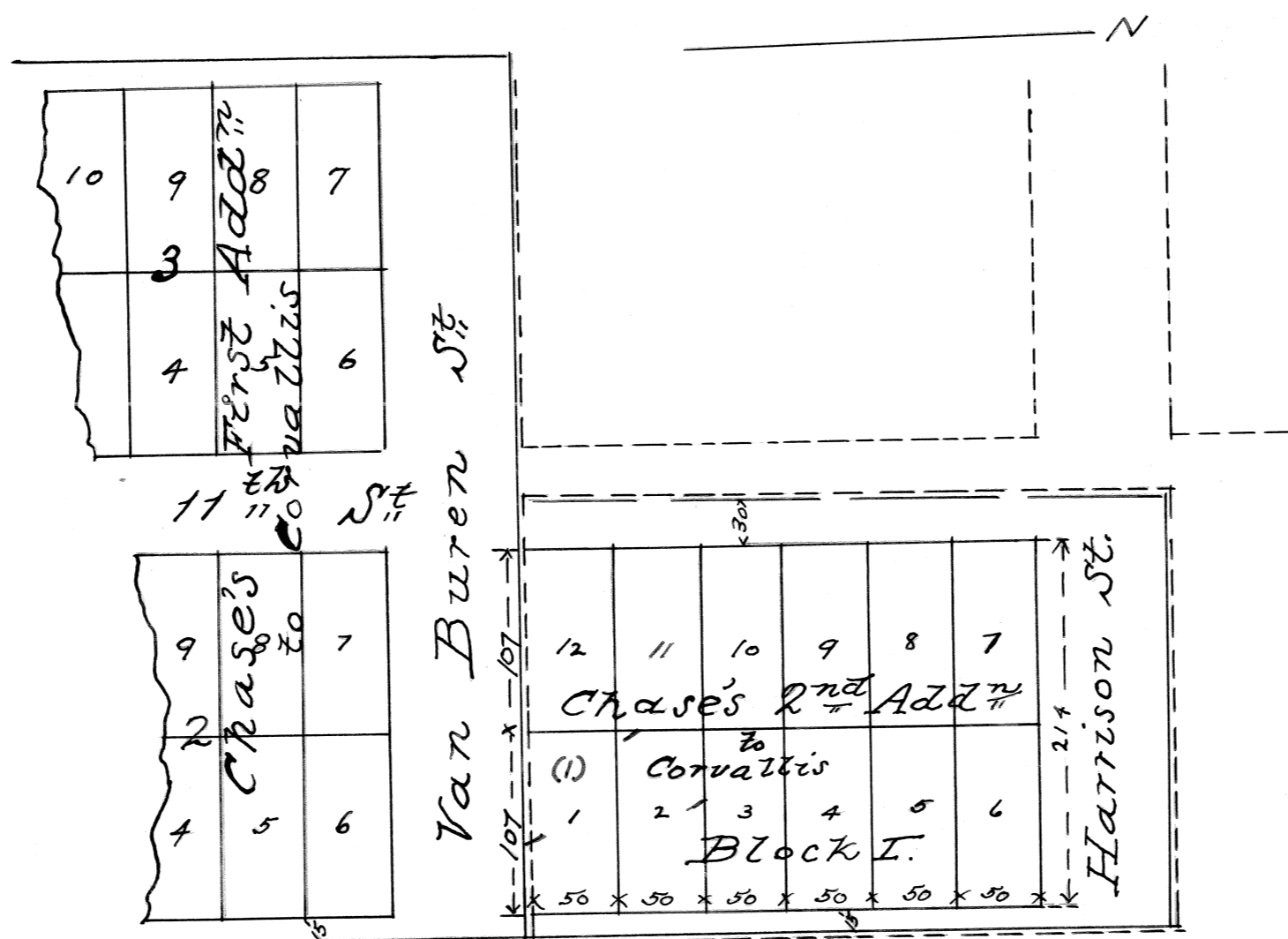
