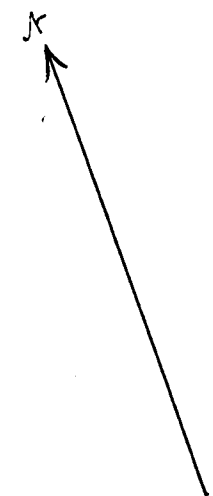
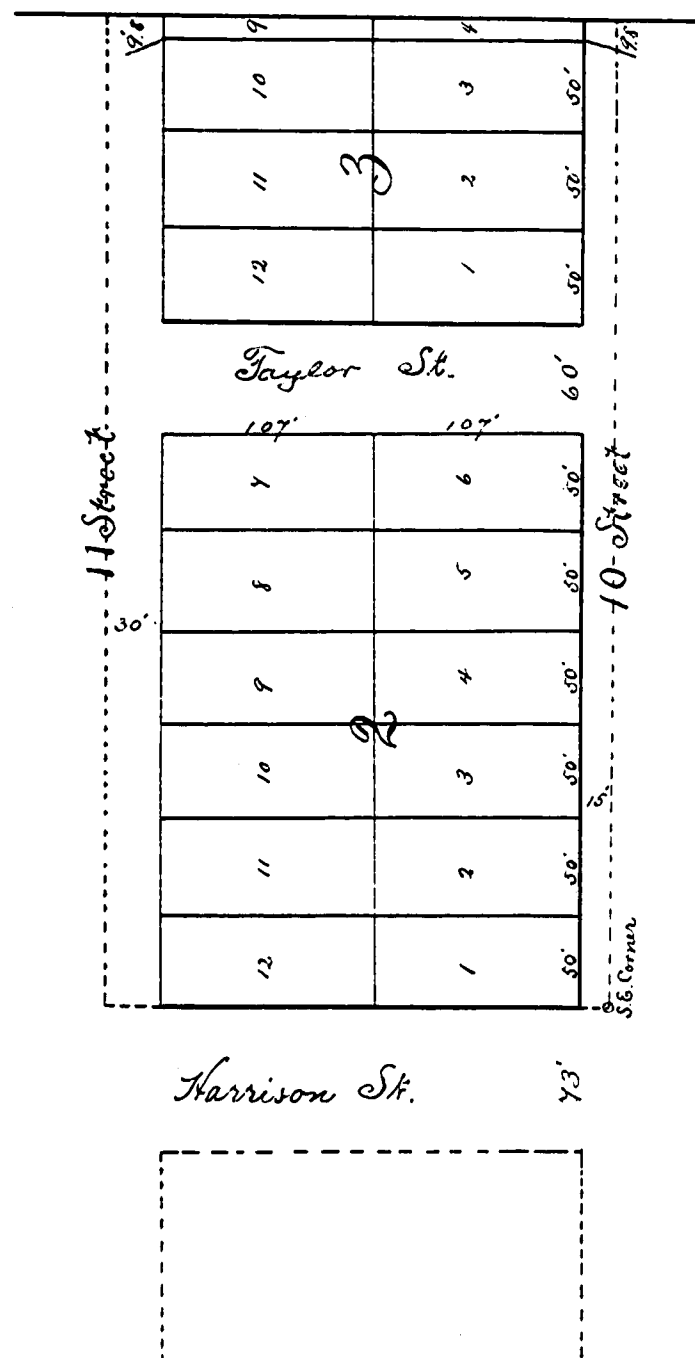


W B Chases Third Addition to the City of Corvallis.

Beginning at a point bearing North 70°30' West 165 feet
distant from the center Honor Street at the point
where the West boundary of the County addition to
the City of Corvallis intersects said street, thence North
19°30' East 1183 feet to Southeast corner of Addition.
