Supplemental Statement and Dedication of
Rayburn's Addition to the City of Corvallis.
Benton County, Oregon.

Know all men by these Presents, that J. W. Rayburn formerly of Corvallis, Oregon, but now of New Whatcom, Washington, and original proprietor of "Rayburn's Addition to the City of Corvallis, Benton County, Oregon," a Dedication of which together with a plat thereof was executed by me and filed in the office of the County Clerk of Benton County, Oregon, on the 10th day of May 1890 and which is recorded at page 114 of Book No 2 of Town plats in said Clerks office, and supplemental thereto and as a part thereof I make this further statement and declaration explanatory of said plat. Namely; That the blocks and lots in my said Addition correspond in width with blocks and lots, in same tier or between same streets, with the blocks and lots in Dixon's Second Addition to the City of Corvallis; and the streets designated on my said plat as Harrison Street and Taylor Street are extended in the same direction exactly as laid out in said Dixon's Second Addition, and the blocks lying between said streets in my said Addition extend from Street line to Street line whether the distance be three hundred feet or three hundred and six feet, it having been my intention originally when I laid out said Addition to conform the width of lots and blocks in my said addition to the corresponding lots and blocks in said Dixon's second Addition, said lots being fifty one feet wide or nearly so and whole blocks being three hundred and six feet wide or nearly so; and the lots in blocks numbered four <4> five <5> and six <6> being of same size as in whole blocks one <1> two <2> and three <3>. I make this declaration of my intention in order to explain on the record a discrepancy

between actual survey of said lots and blocks, which shows blocks to be three hundred and six feet wide, or nearly so, and lots fifty one feet wide, or nearly so, and the plat filed by me which shows lots to be fifty feet wide. Witness my hand and seal this 8th day of April A.D. 1892.
