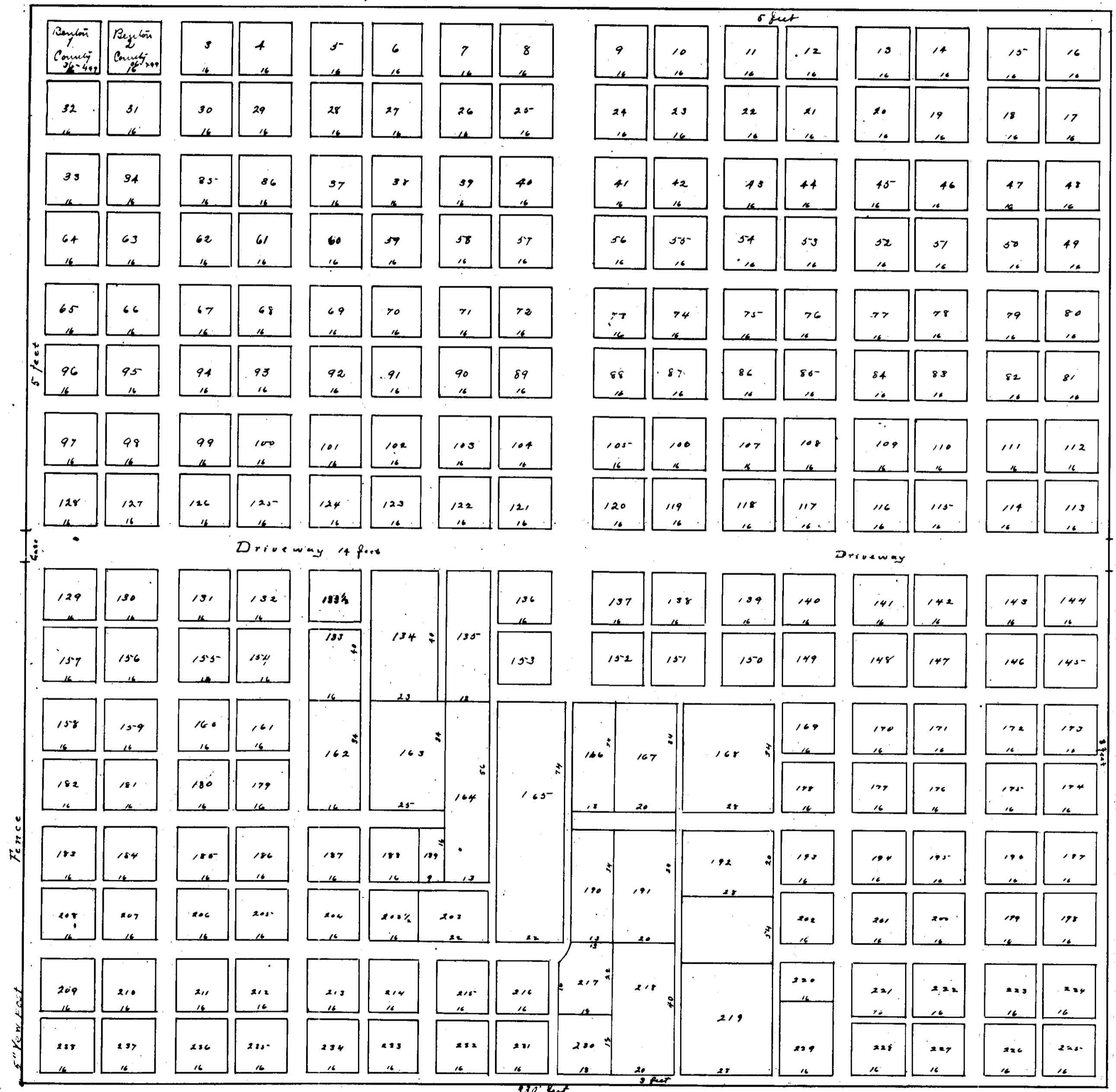


# Simpson's Chapel Cemetery
