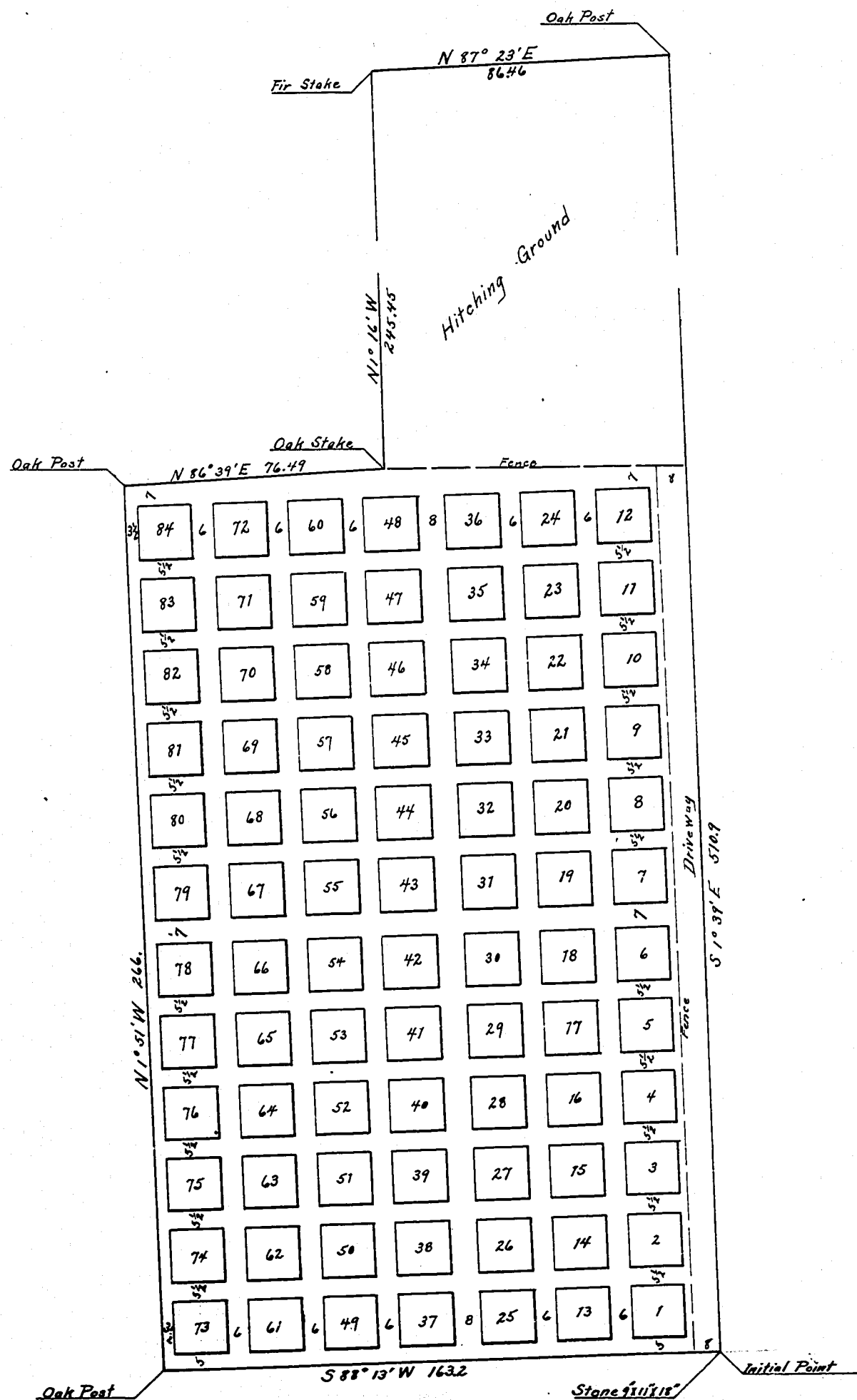


PLAT OF

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that Kings Valley Lodge #44 I.O.O.F., a fraternal order duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Oregon, the proprietor and owner of the lands described in the Surveyor's affidavit on the annexed plat of Oddfellows Cemetery, does hereby plat and lay out said tract of land into blocks, and roads, alley, or walks as shown on the annexed plat as a plat of lands divided into blocks with public highways or walks thereon to be known as "Oddfellows Cemetery, Benton County, Oregon"; said blocks are numbered from 1 to 16 inclusive and blocks, roads, alleys, and walks thereon are of the size and dimensions as marked on the hereunto annexed plat. Dimensions are given in feet. All highways, walks, and alleys on said plat are hereby dedicated to the use of the public.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the said Kings Valley Lodge #44 I.O.O.F. has by resolution of its members thereunto duly passed, caused these presents to be executed by its Presiding Officer, and attested by its Secretary with the seal of the Lodge hereunto affixed, this day of February, 1911.

I, J. A. Ganong, Deputy County Surveyor of Benton County, Oregon, being first duly sworn, say: That I have correctly surveyed and marked with monuments the following described land, to-wit:

Beginning at a stone which is 7793 chs West and 19468 chs North of the Northeast corner of the Donation Land Claim of James Watson it being Claim #40 T. 10 S. R. 6 W. W. M. and running thence S 88° 13' W 163.2 ft, to an oak post; thence N 1° 51' W 266 ft, to an oak post; thence N 86° 31' E 76.49 ft, to an oak stake; thence N 1° 16' W 245.45 ft, to a fir stake; thence N 87° 23' W 86.46 ft, to an oak post; thence S 1° 39' E 510.9 ft, to the place of beginning.

That I planted a proper monument, to-wit: a stone 9"x11"x18" set 6 inches below the surface of the ground, 19468 chs North and 7793 chs West of the Northeast corner of the James Watson D.L.C. #40 Notification #5144 in T. 10 S. R. 6 W. W. M. in Oregon, indicating the initial point of such survey; that a plat of said survey is hereunto annexed.
