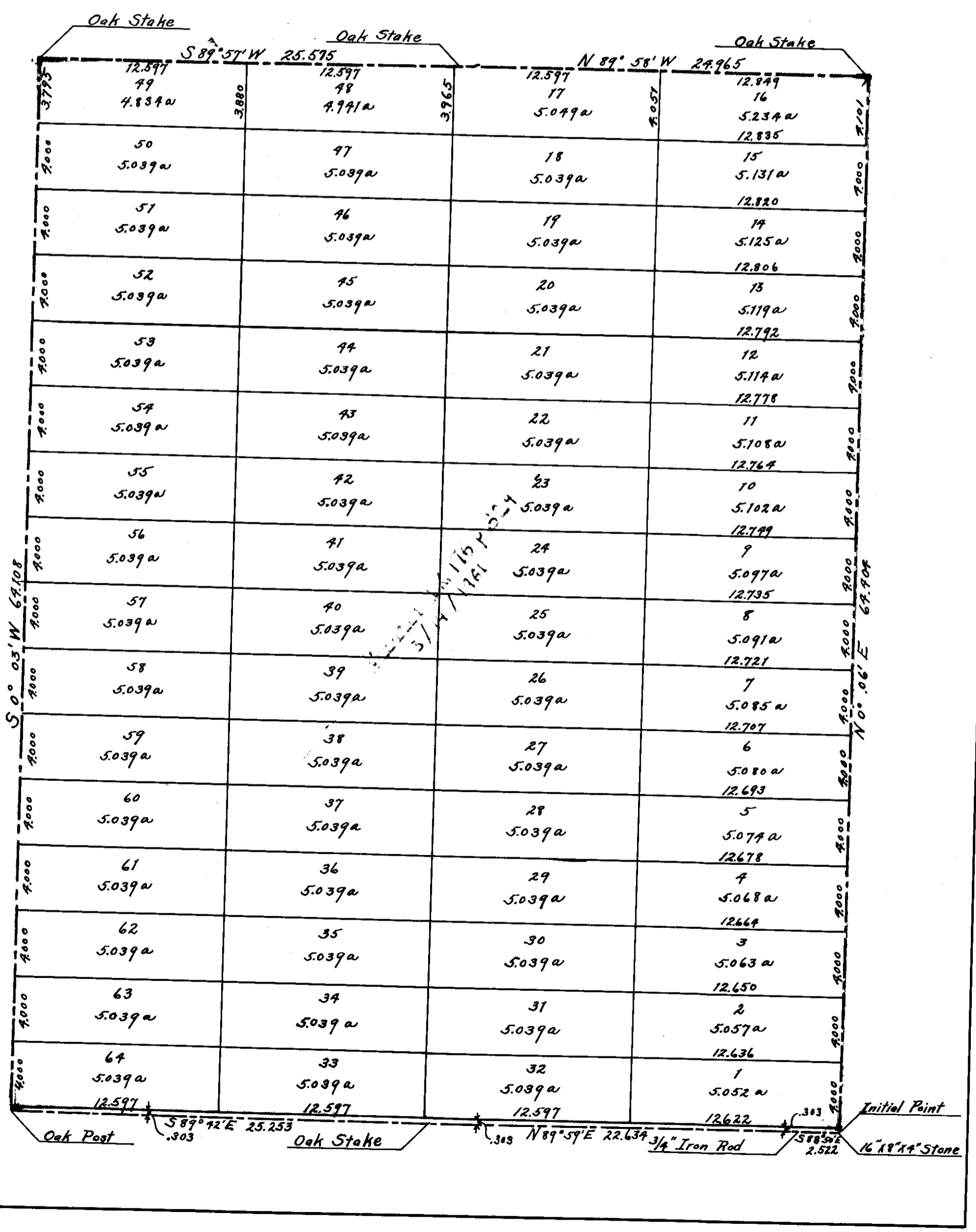


SUBDIVISION OF D.B. & J.L. MULKEY JR. CLAIM'S

I, J.A. Ganong, Deputy County Surveyor of Benton County, Oregon, being first duly sworn, say: That I have correctly surveyed and marked with monuments the following described land, to-wit:  
 Beginning at a stone set six inches below the surface of the ground at the Southeast corner of the Donation Land Claim of D.B. Mulkey it being claim #64 notification #997 in T.p. 11 S. R. 5 W. W.M. and running thence N 0° 06' E 64.909 chs. along the East line of said claim to an oak stake at the Northeast corner of said claim, thence N 89° 58' W 29.965 chs. along the North line of said claim to an oak stake at the Northwest corner thereof, thence S 89° 57' W 25.572 chs. along the North line of the J.L. Mulkey Jr. Cl. to an oak stake at the Northwest corner thereof, thence S 0° 05' W 64.108 chs. along the West line of said J.L. Mulkey Cl. to the Southwest corner thereof, thence S 89° 42' E 25.253 chs. to the Southeast corner of said J.L.
