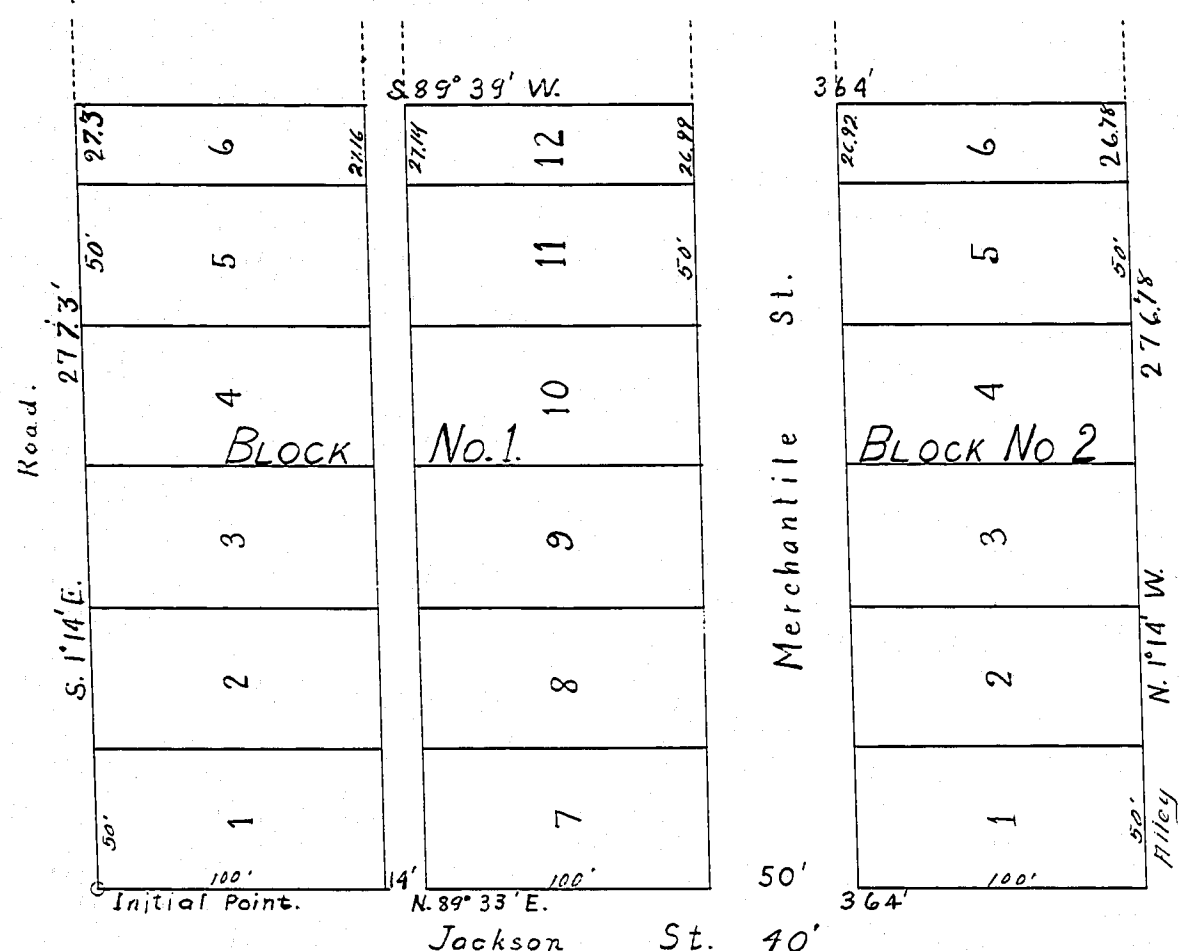


Millers Second Addition.

All dimensions are given in feet and we hereby dedicate said streets and alleys to the use of the public.

I, W. S. Galloway, being first duly sworn, say that I have correctly surveyed and marked with proper monuments the lands represented on this plat and that I planted a monument indicating the initial point of said survey as follows: Set a galvanized iron pipe 2 inches in diameter and three feet in length 6 inches below the surface of the ground, said point being N. 188° 36' E. and W. 123° 28' E. of the interior corner on the east line of the Charles Johnson D.T.S., member 52 Twp. 11 S. R. 5 W. of the W.M. in Benton County, Oregon.

Beginning at the said described initial point and running thence N. 89° 33' E. 364 ft. to a 3/4" pipe at the west side of the alley, thence N. 1° 14' W. along the said west line of alley 276.78 ft. to a 3/4" pipe, thence S. 89° 39' W. 364 ft. to a 3/4" pipe, thence S. 1° 14' E. 277.3 ft. to place of beginning.

That the property heretofore described and surveyed by me is situated within the corporate limits of the City of Corvallis.
