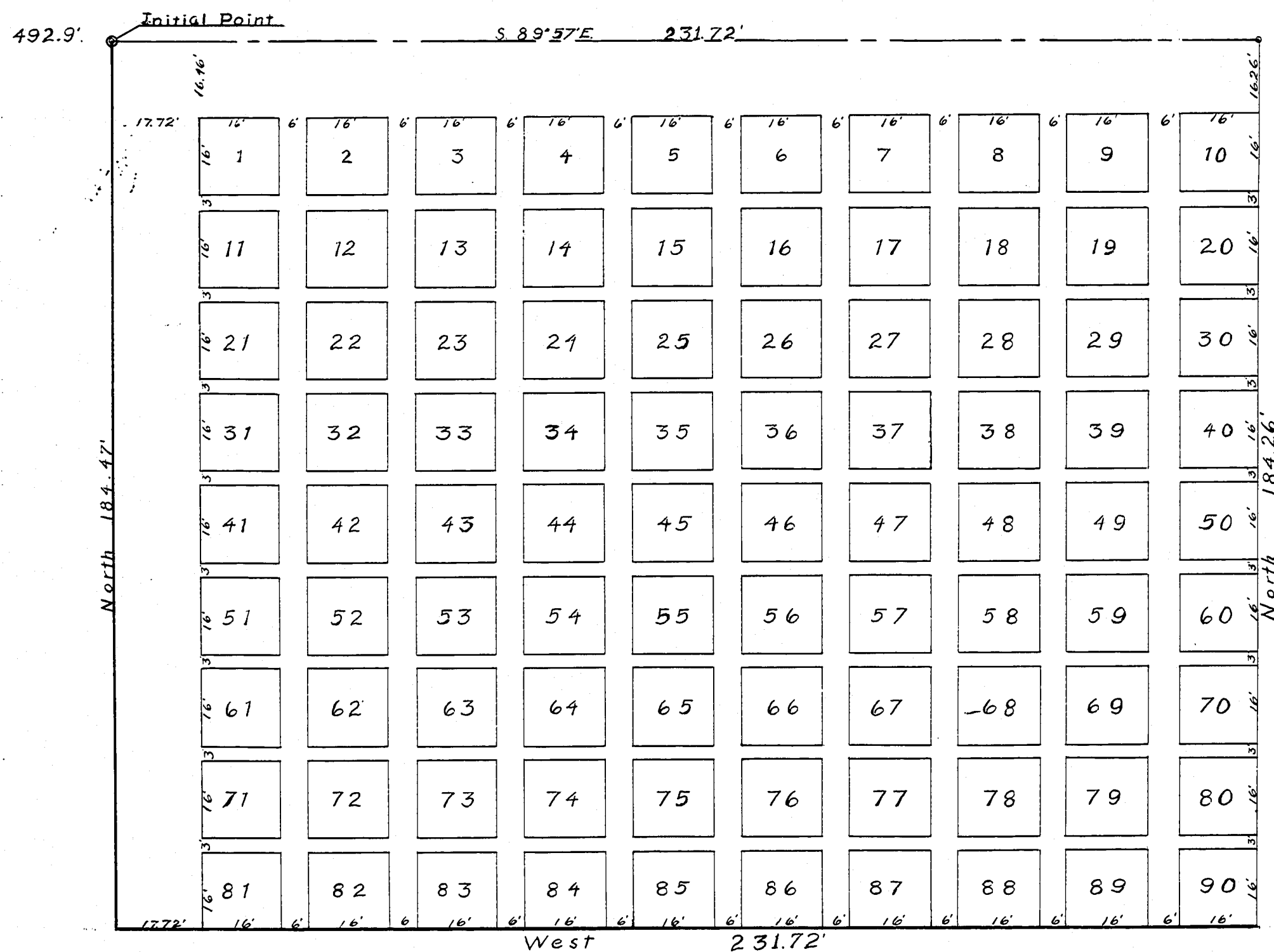


PLEASANT VALLEY CEMETERY

Know All Men By These Presents, That we, R.H. Gellatly, J.L. Henkle and J.E. Henkle, trustees of "Benton County Pleasant Valley Cemetery Association" and as such trustees being proprietors and owners of the land described in the Surveyors Affidavit on the annexed plat of "Pleasant Valley Cemetery" do hereby plat and lay out said tract of land into lots, road and alleys as shown on said plat, to be known as "Pleasant Valley Cemetery". Said lots are numbered from One to Ninety and Lots, Road and Alleys are of size and dimension as marked on the hereunto annexed plat, All dimensions are given in feet, And we hereby dedicate to the use of Public forever without reservation or restriction whatever the road and alleys as shown on said plat.

I, W. C. Galloway, being first duly sworn say: That I correctly surveyed and marked with monuments the following described land, to wit;

Beginning at a 2" X 41" galvanized iron pipe driven in the ground which pipe is on the south line 492.9 feet S. 89° 57' E. of the S. W. corner of Geo. E. Knowlton's D.L.C. #70 Twp. 12 S. R. 6 W. of the Will. Mer. in Benton County, Oregon, and running thence S 89° 57' E. 231.72 feet to a 3/4" galv. pipe, thence South 184.26 feet to a stake, thence West 231.72 feet, thence North 184.47 feet to the place of beginning.

That I set a 2" X 41" galvanized iron pipe 6" below the surface of the ground indicating the initial point of such survey. That the plat of said survey is hereunto annexed.
