I, Walter W. Larsen, being first duly sworn say:- that I surveyed the property hereinafter described and that it is situated within the corporate limits of the City of Corvallis. That I have correctly surveyed and marked with proper monuments the following described land to wit:- Beginning at a 2"x36" pipe 597.11 feet South and 962.24 feet East of the Northeast corner of Chas. Johnson D.L.C. 52, T. 11 S., R. 5 W., Will. Mer, Benton County, Oregon, and running thence N. 0° 55' W. along the East side of Block 10 of College Hill Addition to Corvallis, Benton County, Oregon; 333.33 feet to the North line of said block, thence N. 85° 06' W. along the North line of said block 291.0 feet, thence S. 0° 53' E. 352.12 feet to the south line of Vanburen Street, thence S. 80° 55' E. along the West line of Vanburen Street 293.83 feet to the East line of block 7 of same addition, thence N. 0° 55' W. along the East line of blocks 7 and 10 40.62 feet to beginning.
