I, Walter W. Larsen, being first duly sworn say:- That I surveyed the property hereinafter described, and known as "LILLY ACRES". That I have correctly surveyed and marked with proper monuments the following described land, to wit:- Beginning at a 2 inch by 36 inch pipe on the south line 30.501 chains S. 89° 02' W. of the southeast corner of Jos. C. Alexander D.L.C. No. 46 T. 12 S. R. 5 W. of the Will. Mer. in Benton County, Oregon and running thence S. 89° 02' W. along said Cl. line 9.396 chains to a 3/4" pipe, thence North 26.334 chains to a 3/4" pipe, thence East 9.396 chains to a 3/4" pipe, thence South 26.174 chains to the place of beginning.
