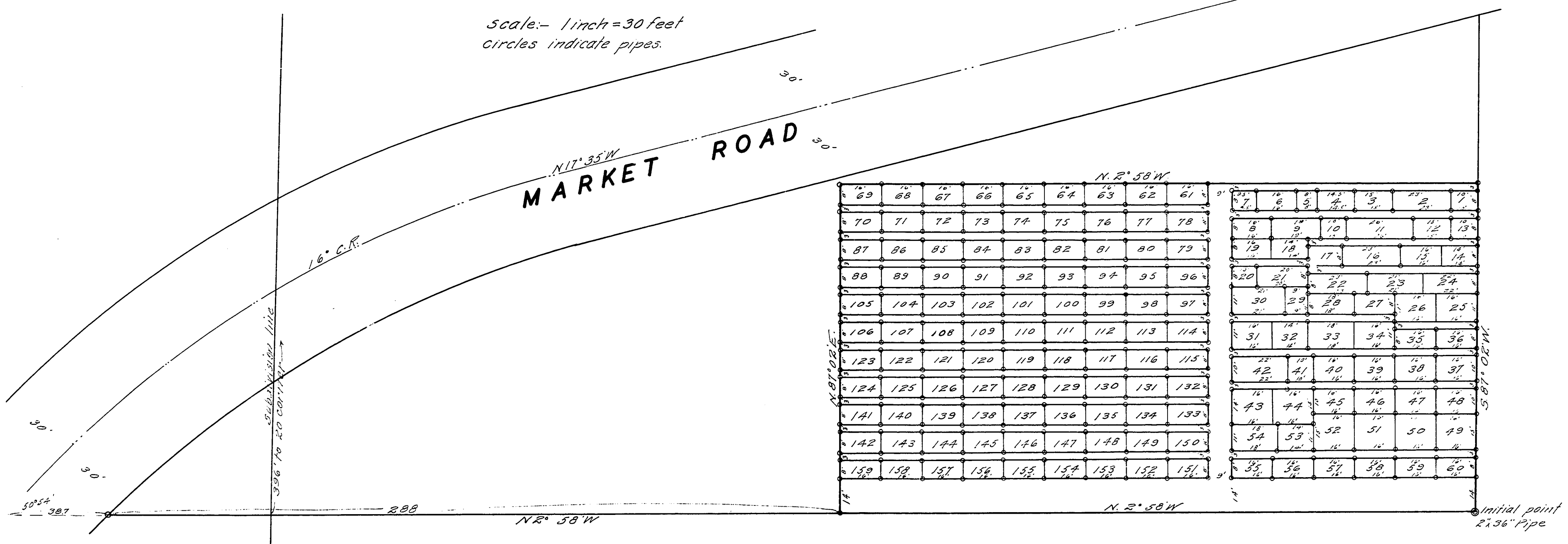
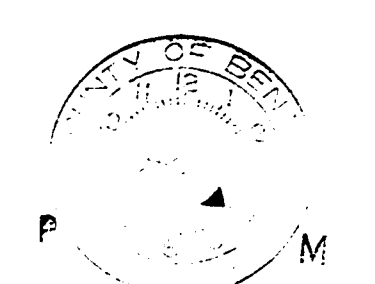


SUMMIT CEMETERY

 I, *Walter W. Larsen*, being first duly sworn say that I have correctly surveyed and marked with monuments the following described land to wit: - Beginning at a 2" x 36" galvanized iron pipe at the northeast corner of the tract from which a fir stump 48" in dia. bears S 34° W. 83.8 feet and a fir stump 30" in dia. bears N 63° W. 66 feet, said pipe being 153.6 feet North and 386.2 feet West of the quarter corner on the south line of section 8 in T. 11 S. R. 7 W of the Will. Mer. in Benton County, Oregon; and running thence S 87° 02' W. 132 feet to a 2" pipe at the northwest corner of said tract, thence S 2° 58' E. 249 feet to a 2" pipe, thence N 87° 02' E. 132 feet, thence N 2° 58' W. 249 feet to the place of beginning, containing .75 of an acre.
 That I set for the initial point a 2 inch galvanized iron pipe 36 inches long driven six inches below the surface of the ground.
