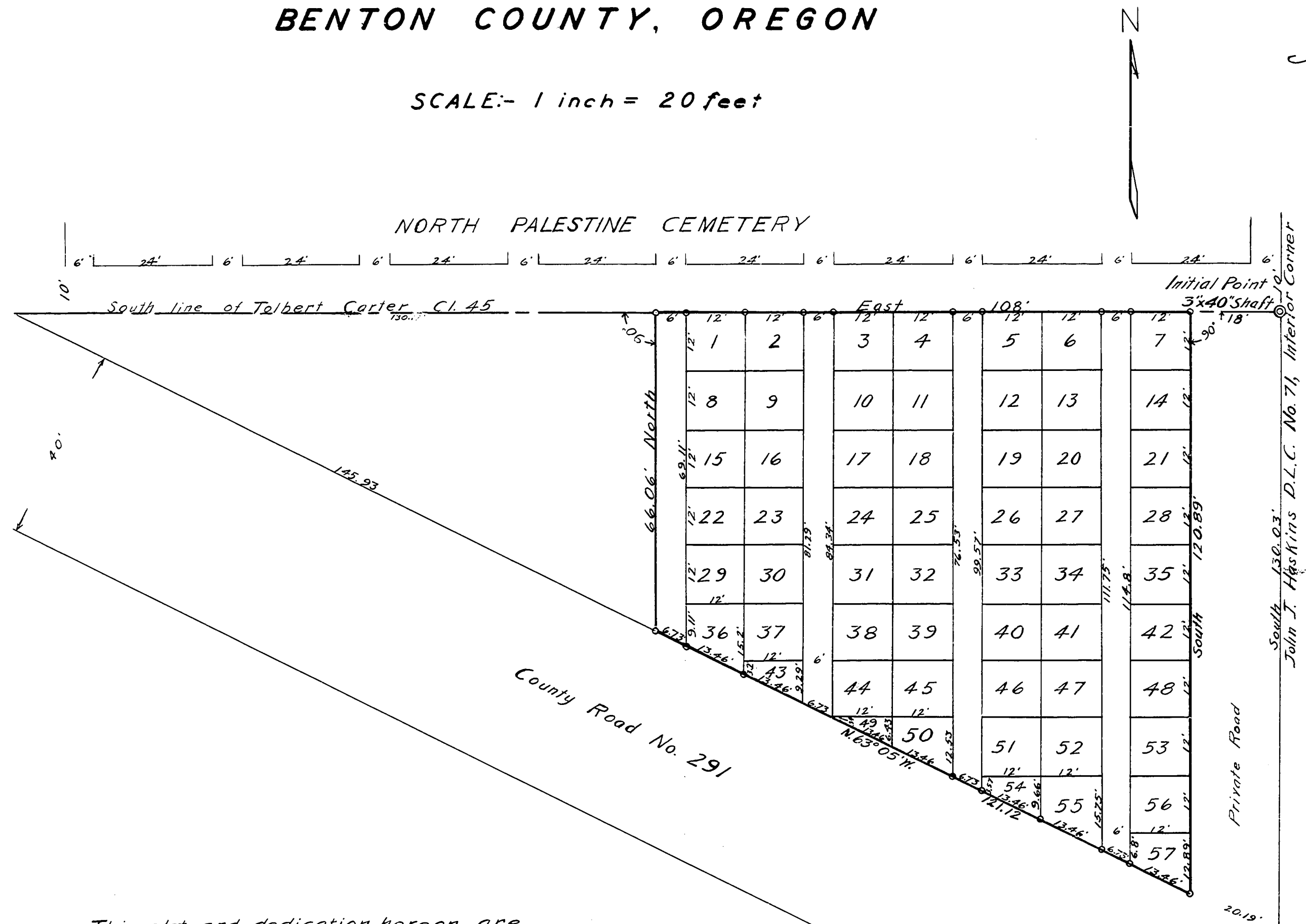


FIRST ADDITION TO NORTH PALESTINE CEMETERY

BENTON COUNTY, OREGON

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That J. A. Carter, J. A. Bailey and W. S. Tomlinson, Trustees of North Palestine Cemetery, owners of the lands described in the Surveyor's affidavit on the unsexed plat of "First Addition to North Palestine Cemetery"; Benton County, Oregon, do hereby dedicate to the public without reservation or restriction whatever the use of the alleys as shown on said plat. Lots in said plat are numbered from 1 to 57 and all alleys are 6 feet wide and lots are 12 feet by 12 feet unless otherwise shown and all distances are in feet.

I, W. C. Galloway, being first duly sworn say:- That I have correctly surveyed and marked with monuments the following described land, to wit:- Beginning at a 3/4" iron rod on the north line 18 feet West of the Interior corner of John J. Hoskins D.L.C. No. 71 T. 10S. R. 4 W. of the Willamette Meridian in Benton County, Oregon, and running thence South 120.89 feet to a 3/4" iron rod on the north line of the County Road, thence N. 63° 05' W. along the north line of said road 121.12 feet to a 1" pipe, thence North 66.06 feet to a 1/2" pipe on the north line of said claim, thence East 108 feet to the place of beginning, containing .46 of an acre.

That I set for the initial point a 3 inch steel shaft 40 inches long six inches below the surface of the ground That said initial point is the Interior corner of John J. Hoskins D.L.C. Number 71 and the Southeast corner of Tolbert Carter D.L.C. T. 10S. R. 4 W. Will. Mer.

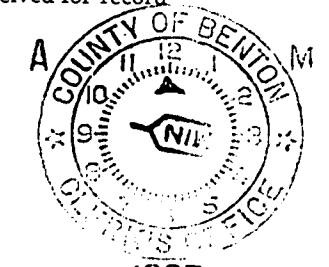
