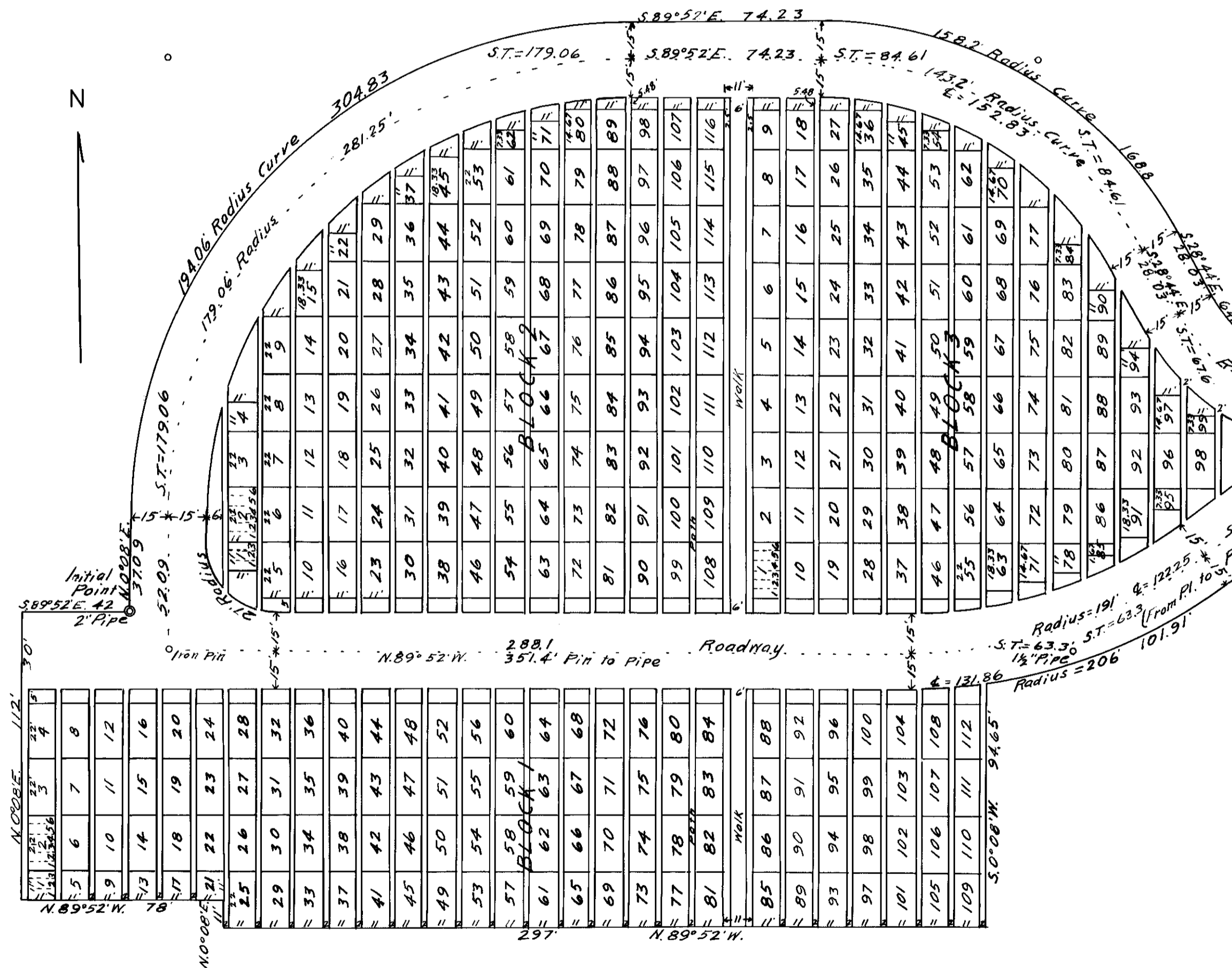


# OAKLAWN MEMORIAL PARK

I, W. C. Galloway, being first duly sworn say that I have correctly surveyed and marked with proper monuments the land as shown on the annexed plat and which is described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the initial point, which is a 2 inch galvanized iron pipe 36 inches long and driven 6 inches below the surface of the ground, that I set said initial point 276.06 feet North and 293.27 feet East of the southeast corner of Prior Scott D.L.C. No. 44 in section 10, T.12 S. R.5 W. of the Will. Mer. in Benton County, Oregon; and running thence N.0°08'E. 37.09 feet to a 3/4" pipe, thence on a 194.06 foot radius curve to the right 304.83 feet to a 3/4" pipe, thence S.89°52'E. 74.23 feet to a 3/4" pipe, thence on a 158.2 foot radius curve to the right 168.8 feet to a 3/4" pipe, thence S.28°44'E. 28.03 feet to a 3/4" pipe, thence on a 64.43 foot radius curve to the left 90.86 feet to a 3/4" pipe, thence S.19°32'E. 30 feet to a 3/4" pipe, thence on a 95.2 foot radius curve to the left, from a line S.70°28'W. through the last point, 28.26 feet to a 3/4" pipe, thence S.53°27 1/2'W. 71.86 feet to a 3/4" pipe, thence on a 206 foot radius curve to the right 101.91 feet to a 3/4" pipe, thence S.0°08'W. 94.65 feet to a 3/4" pipe, thence N.89°52'W. 297 feet to a 3/4" pipe, thence N.0°08'E. 11 feet to a 3/4" pipe, thence N.89°52'W. 78 feet to a 3/4" pipe, thence N.0°08'E. 112 feet to a 3/4" pipe, thence S.89°52'E. 42 feet to the place of beginning, containing 3.13 acres. That the drive or roadway is 30 feet wide and all paths are 2 feet wide and the walk is 6 feet wide.
