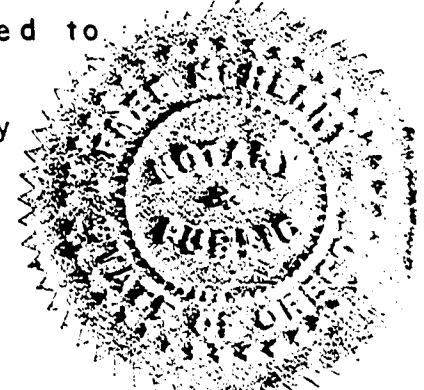

I, W. C. Galloway, being first duly sworn, say that I have correctly surveyed and marked with proper monuments the lands represented on the annexed plat; that as an initial point for said survey I drove a two inch galvanized iron pipe three feet long, six inches below the surface of the ground at a point five feet N. 85° 21' W. of the initial point of Locke Cemetery, which pipe is 1909.7 feet N. 89° 55' W. along the claim line and 757.6 feet S. 2° 23' E. from the northeast corner of A. N. Locke D.L.C. # 41 T. 11 S. R. 5 W. of the Will. Mer. in Benton County, Oregon; and running thence along the boundary lines of said Cemetery N. 85° 21' W. 103.9 feet to a 1 1/2" pipe, S. 6° 17' W. 249.5 feet to a 2" pipe and S. 85° 35' E. 251.8 feet to a 1 1/4" pipe the southeast corner of said Cemetery, thence S. 4° 25' W. 286.5 feet to a 3/4" iron rod, thence N. 85° 35' W. 271.8 feet to a 3/4" iron rod, thence N. 4° 25' E. 286.5 feet to a 3/4" iron rod 20 feet N. 85° 35' W. of the southwest corner of said Cemetery, thence N. 6° 17' E. 269.6 feet to a 3/4" iron rod thence N. 80° 17' E. 120.94 feet to a 3/4" iron rod on the west line of a 10 foot road, thence S. 2° 23' E. 50.38 feet to the place of beginning, containing 2.00 acres.
