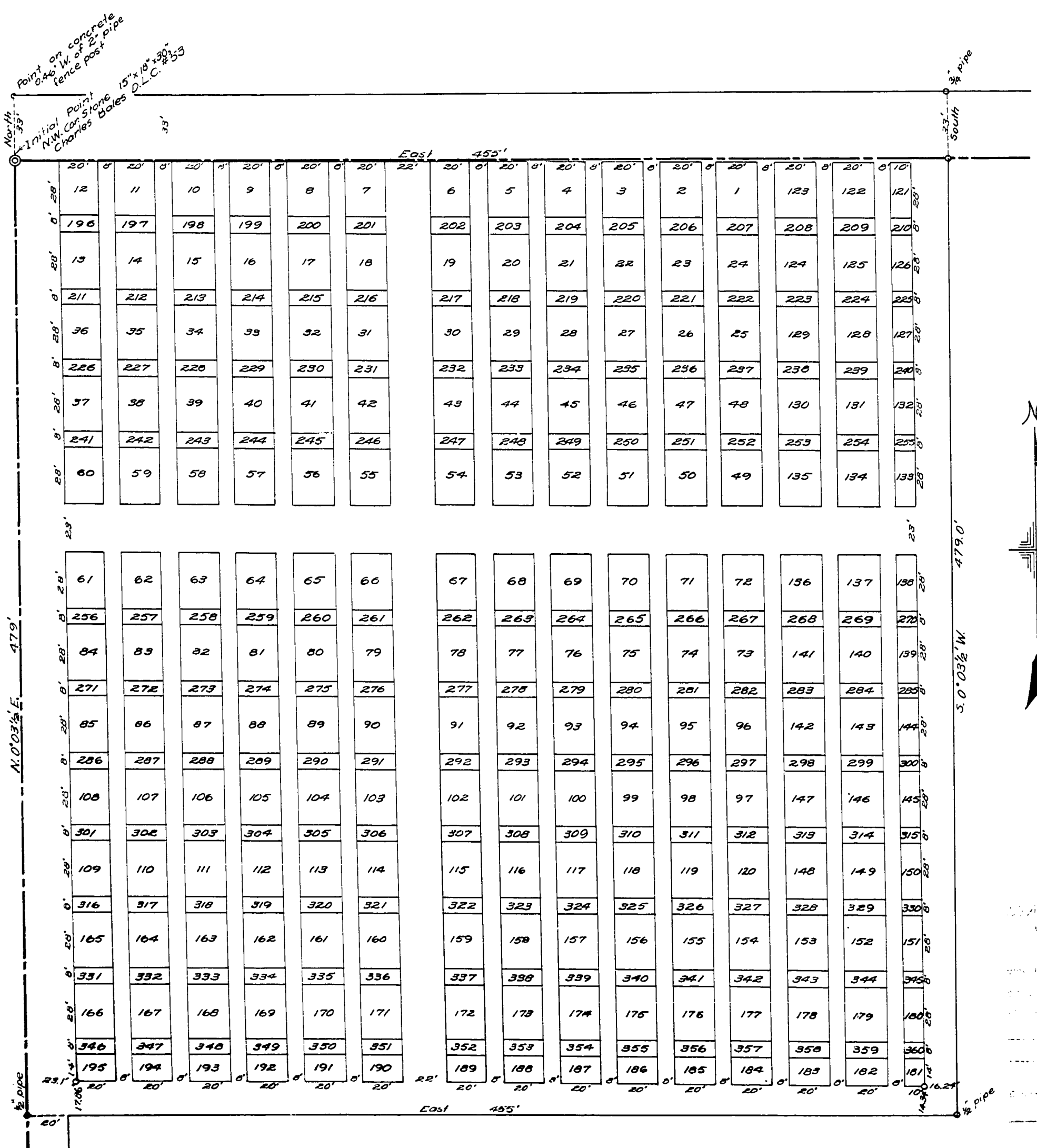


SUPPLEMENTAL PLAT OF MT. UNION CEMETERY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that we, M.B. Long, H.C. Wyatt, and Mary Thompson, trustees of MT. UNION CEMETERY Association, being the proprietors and owners, as such trustees, of the land shown on the annexed plat that is to be known as the "SUPPLEMENTAL PLAT OF MOUNT UNION CEMETERY, Benton County, Oregon." We hereby dedicate the streets and alleys as shown on said plat, without reservation or restriction, to the use of the public. The original plat of Mt. Union Cemetery, containing lots from 1 to 120 was recorded June 21, 1879, Book 1, page 16 of town and cemetery records, the Addition made thereto and dedicated, containing lots from 121 to 195, was recorded in Book 3 Page 10 of said records, and this Supplement containing lots from 196 to 360 are as shown on this said plat.

I, W.C. Galloway, being first duly sworn depose and say that I have correctly surveyed and marked with proper monuments the land represented on the annexed plat, that as an initial point for said survey I used the Northwest corner stone of the Charles Bales D.L.C. #53 in T. 12 S. R. 5 W. of the Will. Mer. in Benton County, Oregon; running thence North 33 feet to a point on a concrete block, thence East, parallel to the north line of said claim, 455 feet to a 1/2" pipe, thence South 33 feet to a 1/4" pipe on the north line of said claim, thence S. 0° 02 1/2' W., parallel to the west line of said claim, 479 feet to a 1/2" pipe, thence West, parallel to the north line of said claim, 455 feet to a 1/2" pipe on said claim line, thence N. 0° 02 1/2' E. 479 feet to the place of beginning, containing 5.35 acres.
