


## NARRATIVE

This map is the result of Benton County Community
Development Department File No. LU-04-084. It depicts a
property line adjustment — the transfer of 0.25 acres from
Property 1 (Dalton) to Property 2 (Mullen).
Lot 2, Block 1, HIGHLAND PARK, was divided by deed

Lot 2, Block 1, HIGHLAND PARK, was divided by deed conveyance into 4 parts in 1963. Three of those tracts were conveyed to Fred and Evelyn Dalton per Book 186, Page 359 and Book 186, Page 361. The Dalton's gained title to the last portion of the Lot in 1991 per M-132737-91 (Tax Lot 300). Ronald and Donna Mullen got title to the most easterly tract (TL 100) in 2000 per M-280978-00.

I surveyed the properties in 2000 per CS 9521. I found my 2000 field survey control network and used it for this present project. Thus I show identical data between monuments common to the 2 projects.
