



**NARRATIVE:** The purpose of this survey was to establish the points shown hereon and to establish the rights of way to the various parcels at the direction of C.E. Jones, owner. Points shown are not necessarily on the legal subdivision lines nor on the south boundary of the Jones parcel and deed elements did not determine the establishment of the monuments, except for the two monuments set 25 ft south of the south line of the Thomas Norrie claim south line. The basis on which the lines were established were the found monuments at points 'A' and 'B' using the record bearing of "South" as shown on C.S. 7421. All monuments set were #5 rebar 30 inches long with yellow plastic caps stamped L.S. 501. Authorization for this size drawing was granted by Pete McDowell, Benton County Surveyor's office on March 30, 1983.
